Kruel is Kind to Crusaders

December 21 - Coral Springs, FL - Bergen Catholic won the Kruel Classic in South Florida this Tuesday following its 62-51 win over South Gwinnett High School of Georgia. South Gwinnett was 13-0 entering the contest and ranked #2 in the Peach State.



The Crusaders opened the game strong with a 12-2 run. All three contests this tournament have ended with a considerable first quarter lead for the Crusaders and this game was no different. BC led 14-7 after one.



The Comets brought a 13-0 record into this game and fought to a 18-18 tie midway through the second. They proceeded to put BC on its heels as that run continued to produce a three-point lead 25-22,

but leadership of seniors Will Richardson (19 pts, 7 steals) and Elias Espinosa (4 first half points) kicked in to help BC re-establish a four-point lead at half 33-29.

WILL RICHARDSON REACHES 1,000 POINTS

December 21 - Coral Springs, FL - In BC's third game of the 2021 Season, Senior Guard Will Richardson became the seventeenth player in school history to surpass the 1000 point mark. Will entered the season with 950 points and his 19 points vs. Miami Sr. HS (FL), 24 vs Windermere Prep (FL) and 16 vs South Gwinnette (GA) in the Championship Game put him over the top with 1,009 career points to date.



The last three players to reach the 1,000 point mark, Doug Edert, Zach Freemantle and Matt Zona, all shared the court with Will throughout his career. The Fordham bound guard is a four year starter for the Crusaders. He was a key contributor to BC's run to the Tournament of Champions Final in 2019 and Bergen's State Championship Team in the Covid-19-shortened tournament in 2020.

BIRD OF THE YEAR NORTHERN LAPWING



December 22 - Alloway, NJ - What can I say? This is definitely BOTW worthy, but for 2021, it's a no-brainer Bird of the Year!

There is only one reason I travel to Salem County, New Jersey: a bird. In this case, it was a rare bird. If you've seen the greatest Birding movie ever made, *The Big Year*, with Jack Black, Steve Martin, Owen Wilson, Rashida Jones, Rosemund Pike, Anjelica Huston, Brian Dennehy and Diane Wiest, you've heard the term "Code 4." No, not "Code Red" like in *A Few Good Men*...Code 4.

For its checklist, the American Birding Association assigns a code number for each bird that has been recorded in North America; generally speaking, the higher the code number, the rarer the bird. As defined by the ABA on its website, code 4 birds are "species not recorded annually in the ABA Checklist Area, but with six or more total records—including three or more in the past 30 years—reflecting some pattern of occurrence."

The Northern Lapwing is one of those such birds. The birds live in temperate Eurosiberia and generally require a number winter storms to usher it our way. I heard people talking about the northern lapwing of the 1920's seen in New Jersey and people hypothesizing that this may be "the lapwing" that was earlier spotted in Maine this year. Regardless, for me it was my first Northern Lapwing, a "lifer." Life bird #420 to be exact, and it was my 280th species identified this year... my best year to date.

Takeaways from this bird. It has beautiful iridescent green feathers, much like the much, much smaller hummingbirds we saw in Arizona. It is a plover-like bird, similar to a killdeer, but about 2 inches larger with a wingspan that is nearly 9" wider. It had beautiful facial markings and It was graceful in flight as its wings seemed to undulate like someone doing the wave with their arms extended. He caught a worm while I was watching him. He also stretched his long, rounded wings. This bird was a joy for a birder to see as it seemed very generous with his various poses and actions. This was a terrific early Christmas gift for certain! If I happen to find the Stellar's Sea Eagle before New Year's Day, this bird will lose its title, but for now, it's #1 for 2021.
