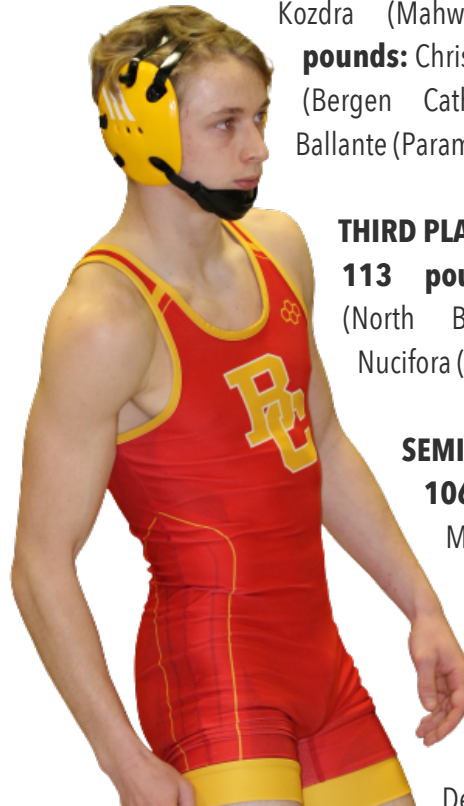

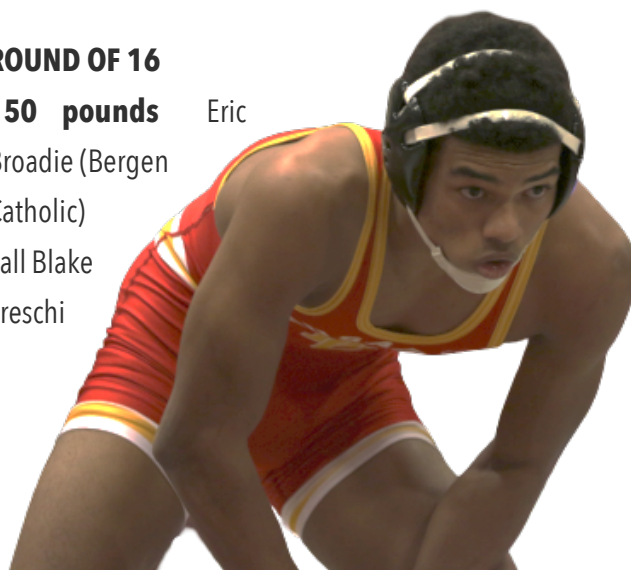

BIRD OF THE WEEK

SANDHILL CRANE



January 15 - Tampa, FL - As my sons and I were leaving a shopping mall in the sunshine state, we encountered two Sandhill Cranes (pictured above). These are some of the most graceful birds you will ever encounter, feathered in a soft gray downy coat with a burgundy forehead and blood-red eyes.

DID YOU KNOW?

- While some Sandhill Cranes begin breeding at two years old, some wait until they are as old as seven. Then, they mate for life, staying close with their mate for decades. Their offspring will remain with the parents for 9-10 months after being hatched, though they can leave the nest within 8 hours of being hatched and can even swim at that age.
- The earliest Sandhill Crane fossil was 2.5 million years old, found in Florida.
- The oldest Sandhill Crane was at least 36 years, 7 months old. It was banded in Wyoming in 1973 and found in New Mexico in 2010.
