

February 19 - Wayne, NJ - The Varsity Wrestling Team added another chapter to its legendary volume by setting a state record: 13 Individual District Champions in one tournament. The last bout of the night, BC fell just short of perfection (a 2-1 defeat) to the wrestler who would become the evening's Most Outstanding Wrestler.

Needless to say, BC won the team title, their 33rd District Title and 32nd in a row dating back to 1990 (2021 there was



no tournament due to the pandemic).

REGIONAL WRESTLING SEVEN CHAMPS AND 5 SILVERS ADVANCE TO ATLANTIC CITY

February 26 - Mount Olive, NJ - Twelve of BC's fourteen

wrestlers have advanced to the NJSIAA State Tournament this coming weekend in Atlantic City.

Brian Melamud led the way at 106, knocking off the top-seed in the finals in a battle of outstanding sophomores. Christopher Nucifora (113 pounds) made the most of his sixth seed, placing second and punching his ticket to AC, defeating the 3 and 7 seeds before losing in the final.

Aiden Wallace (126 pounds) took his top seed and ran the table, earning a tech fall and two decisions en-route to his title. At 132 pounds, Ryan Ford pinned three opponents to snag his championship and Joe Cangro won the Region II Title with a pin, a tech fall and a decision at 138 pounds.

Chris Bacchioni and Eric Broadie each earned silver at 144 and 157 respectively which led to the headline match of the evening. Nick Fea took his #2 seed to pin all the way



BIRD OF THE WEEK IT'S ALL ABOUT THE JOURNEY



February 22 - Five Islands, ME - With time away from classes this week, I decided to pursue a bird. This is a RARE BIRD. The rarest I would chase. I drove to Poughkeepsie, NY where I watched my sons and two alumni who attend Vassar College (Dan Negron and Kyle Loughlin) competing in a collegiate lacrosse game. Afterwards, I chose a road less travelled. I drove six hours in the rain north to Bath, ME to look for a <u>Steller's Sea Eagle</u>. This is the bird, you may have heard about, that is the first ever recorded in the lower 48. It is an Asian bird, weighing twice as much as a Bald Eagle.

As I woke up early the next day, I took the 13 minute ride over to the bridge where it had been spotted on 2/19/2022 to wait and see. We had the Bird Alerts going. We had the GroupMe App loaded. Our binoculars were scanning tree tops as we shared stories. One gentleman taught high school aged young men, though it was in a prison environment. Convicted rapists, burglars, drug dealers and a couple of murderers were among his students.

They did not win a county basketball championship. They did not win a district wrestling championship. They did not set a record as the fastest kid in the history of their school. They were in jail.

We never saw the bird, but I share this picture of a boat I happened upon. It gave me pause to think: How truly blessed are we to have our freedom, to be able to gather at BC every day? How truly blessed was I to have the energy and will to pursue this bird and make it home safely?

I think of our Crusaders. Make the most of your days while you're at BC. You are in a truly blessed school. Relish in the pursuit of your dreams while you're here. When these short years are over, you will not get them back. Don't let them get away with dreams of tomorrow, for those dreams are made upon the memories you create today!

I'm so glad I went to Maine. I did not see my bird, but I can dream of seeing it another time, and I'll always have the experience and memories I made with those who stood on that bridge with me.
