## BASKETBALL BRINGS HOME BC'S THIRD STATE TITLE THIS YEAR!

### *Crusader* BASKETBALL

**March 12 - Piscataway, NJ** - BC avenged a regular season defeat to the Argonauts of Rutgers Prep to win the fifth basketball state championship in school history 66-54. The victory was the third team state championship, joining Football and Wrestling, this academic year.

#### CRUSADERS WIN NON-PUBLIC

#### "A" NORTH SECTIONAL TITLE

**March 9 - Franklin Twp., NJ** - Simply better. Every step of the way. Minute-by-minute, quarter-by-quarter, the Crusaders were simply better than anything the Ironmen could throw at them en-route to the school's eleventh NPA North Sectional Title in Franklin Township on Wednesday night. The Crusaders took a 69-57 victory over the Ironmen, that was not without its struggles.

The first quarter was between two prize fighters testing one another out, with BC holding a 2 point lead.

Bosco would be a little more spirited throughout the second period



gaining a lead of 12-11 and 14-11, but the Crusaders responded and grabbed a lead at 16-14 which they would never relinquish.

Elias Espinosa dropped two three pointers throughout the course of the evening. His timely shooting (once in the first half and again in the second) always seems to be especially clutch and more often than not, forces opponents to call time out to regroup as it did in this game.

Julian Brown led the Crusaders in scoring, taking opportunities to drive to the hoop, but more importantly, knocking down 10 free throws when the Ironmen's hopes







were only pinned on fouling BC in the fourth quarter.

The play of BC's twin tower sophomores, Terry Copeland and Brandon Benjamin has been the one thing the Ironmen simply cannot contend with. Since Copeland's return, BC has been nearly unstoppable. The two combined for 24 points, 17 rebounds, 2 assists and Benjamin added four blocked shots for good measure.



The individual stat of the night was accomplished by Will Richardson however, who eclipsed Sean Banks '02 twenty-year old scoring record of 1,519 points. It was his thirteenth point (of 19), which came with 3:56 remaining in the third quarter, giving BC a 30-25 lead.

The Crusaders will look to make amends on a January 15<sup>th</sup> 70-64 defeat at the hands of Rutgers Prep. The two will tip it off in the
