May 5 - Montvale, NJ - The Crusaders defeated the Green Knights 4-1 on Thursday.





DIVISION DAY LIFTS BC TO 25-0



BIRDS OF THE MET



May 13 - New York City, NY - I was graciously inivited to escort Mr. Tedeschi's AP European History students to the Metropolitan Museum of

Art.

While there, I enjoyed enriching myself, viewing ancient pottery, works of art and coats of armor from the Roman Empire in the centuries BC and early AD.

A number of renaissance painting told biblical stories and provided a perspective on early Christian life that our culture does not often consider.

We often may forget how difficult life was for people in those days as we bellyache about how difficult our lives in the most privileged time period in man's history.

But that's for another time and place. This is about the birds. Toward the end of my self-guided tour (I put in about 6,500 steps) I came across some 18th century German art…birds!

I think my favorite is the magpie (located just between the mallards).
