2022 BERGEN CATHOLIC CRUSADERS AT A GLANCE

The Crusaders enter today's game under the direction of Head Coach, Vito Campanile, the eleventh coach in program history. Coach Campanile has done nothing but polish an apple, leading the Crusaders to back-to-back #1 state rankings and a perfect 12-0 record with a #3 ranking in the USA by MaxPreps...the highest national ranking ever in school history.

Coach Campanile's record at the helm is now a gaudy 32-7 (.821 winning percentage) through his first four years.

THE CRUSADERS ON OFFENSE

A new era begins under center for the Crusaders as Steve Angeli (Notre Dame) graduates after leading BC to back-to-back #1 seasons. Senior #16 Jack Duffy is ready to step in and fire. Sophomore #17 Dominic Campanile will provide a steady hand for the Crusaders and will get some snaps.

Senior RB #7 Saeed St. Fleur returns in the backfield after a very solid junior campaign. Out of the backfield, Saeed rushed for 739 yards and 8 touchdowns and gained 1016 in yards from scrimmage. Maryland-commit and TE DJ Samuels may see some short-yardage action as the senior picked up two touchdowns in minimal carries in 2021.

The QBs will have a couple of very nice receiving threats with Senior TE and Princeton-commit #13 Jack Comeau (who returns with 13 catches for 171 yards and WRs # 2 Christian Carti, #4 Logan Casey and sophomore #15 Quincy Porter who will threaten opposing defenses down the field.

On the line, look for #67 Sean Woods, #55 Dylan Garrity, #50 Marcus Linder, #79 Nyier Daniels, #74 Justin King, #64 Owen Fernandez and #60 Michael Gentilello to open some holes for St. Fleur.

BERGEN CATHOLIC ON DEFENSE

The Crusaders start with some play-makers up-front. Maryland-bound DE #6 DJ Samuels is already Bergen Catholic's all-time leading sacker with 22 career sacks (overtaking notables like Brad Dussault 21, Brian Cushing (All-Pro LB), Kurt Holuba (2x Ivy Defensive Player of the Year), Jimmy Dray (NFL) among countless other legends. And if you want to commit double-teams to Samuels, offenses will need to develop schemes to block Texas-bound DT #90 Sydir Mitchell. The 6'3, 315 pound Mitchell recorded 40 tackles, 4.5 TFLs and 1 sack in his 2021 campaign.

The team's leading tackler, #5 Malachi Mercer, leads a strong linebacking corp. His 103 tackles were tops for BC in 2021 and he added 3 sacks and 8.5 TFLs as well.

In the secondary, #8 Daquan Stewart returns at one corner position and sophomore Naiim Parrish to lockdown the other side. Safeties #12 Kaj Sanders and #14 Chris Mimmo fill out the rest of the secondary.

BERGEN CATHOLIC SPECIAL TEAMS

The Crusaders return a madman in Mimmo who returns punts with reckless abandon. His 110 yards in PR and 178 KO return yards led the Crusaders in 2021.

Transfer junior #25 Brandon Arpacilar is likely to do much of the punting for the Crusaders. They have a capable alternate with #86 Richie Reid who averaged just over 30 yards per punt last season.

Look for #37 Guytano Bartolomeo to focus on the precision place-kicking while BC will rely on the big leg of kicker Carmelo Verlardo (#9) to drive the ball deep on kick offs and win the game of field position.

ARCHBISHOP GIBBONS CRUSADERS AT A GLANCE



The Crusaders enter today's game under the direction of Head Coach, Steven Wright. Coach Wright is now in his 12th season at the helm of the Crusaders. He boasts an exceptional 114-27 record entering the 2022 campaign. That's good for an .809 winning percentage.

Wright and his Crusaders look to rebound following a 28-14 defeat at the hands of Julius L. Chambers HS (Charlotte, NC) in their 2022 season opener.

The two schools had history, battling it out in the opener of the 2021 season in a game that saw the Cougars' victory over Gibbons reversed as AG won by forfeit.

Both teams reached the state finals and were able to settle things on the field. Cardinal Gibbons won 14-2 to secure their spot at North Carolina's top team, finishing with a 16-0 record.

THE CRUSADERS ON OFFENSE

The Crusaders are led by 6'6 senior QB, #18 Connor Clark, who threw for over 1400 yards and 18 touchdowns in 2021. In the opener vs. Chambers, Clark was 18 for 33 and 170 yards with no interceptions.

His top target is WR #4 Landen Lawrence who scored a touchdown on 49 receiving yards. TE #15 Brock Chappel hauled in 40 yards worth of passes and a TD and WR #2 Nick Lemon added 38 yards receiving.

The Crusaders will need to get something going with their running game to take some pressure off Clark and Company. Sophomore RB #21 Kendall Scotton and FB #99 Joshua Stoneking look to do much of the ball carrying.

THE CRUSADERS ON DEFENSE

BC had better find a way to protect their first year starting QB from the likes of Defensive End #45 Donovan Dozier who recorded a sack and 6 tackles last week.

Safety #22 Corban McDaniel is a ball-hawking sophomore who recorded two interceptions. Know where he is ion the field! His partner in crime, safety #5 Blake Raphael led the Crusaders with 7 tackles and #99 FB/DT Stoneking is a presence on the line, recording 6 tackles in the opener.

CRUSADER SPECIAL TEAMS

Senior Kicker #35 Daniel Monte was perfect on his two PAT last weekend. He has a leg that can pin an opponent deep and he recorded 2 touchbacks in his opener.

Monte also punted five times, averaging 31.8 per punt. Sophomore #85 Johnny Carlucci had one opportunity and made the most of it with a 41 yard punt.

Electric returner #25 Braylon Peebles is just a freshman, but his 23 yards average per KORet and 11 yard average per Punt Return have people raising some eyebrows.

IT'S AN HONOR!

Coach Campanile took the helm at Bergen Catholic in 2018, succeeding brother, Nunzio, who led BC to a state championship in 2017. Coach Vito immediately found success during the 2018 season, leading BC to the state final before the Crusaders were upset by St. Joseph Regional at MetLife Stadium.

Following a five-and-four 2019 campaign, Covid-19 prevented Campanile's #1-ranked Crusaders from pursuing a state championship as the state tournament was cancelled for the season.

In 2021, Coach Campanile led BC to its 18th state championship and second-ever 12-0 record. The Crusaders were the class of the state of New Jersey and earned the school's highest ever ranking to date of #3 in the country.

In recognition of his commitment to excellence and leadership, Coach Campanile was recognized by the **USAToday** as the Nation's High School Boys Coach of the Year.



In four years at the helm of BC, Coach Campanile has a record of 32-7 (.821 winning percentage), one state championship and two #1 rankings in NJ. In his 16-year head coaching career, Coach Campanile has a record of 115-57 with a .685 winning percentage.

TODAY IN BERGEN CATHOLIC FOOTBALL: AUGUST 27

2021: The Crusaders travelled to Ohio to take on defending State Champion, Archbishop Hoban. Coach Vito Campanile's

team once again proved to be extremely well-prepared, dominating their host by a score of 42-7.

The Crusaders were hitting on all cylinders as Notre Dame-bound QB, Steve Angeli was nearly perfect in the air (14/16-195, 2TD) and he added a score with his feet. Princeton-bound Ryan Butler was only really stopped by the endzone, scoring a pair of touchdowns and carrying 12 times for 62 yards.

Junior RB Saeed St. Fleur recorded a TD and LB Malachi Mercer led the Crusaders with 11 tackles.

AUGUST OPENERS

Today's game vs. Cardinal Gibbons is just the third contest in 65 years of BC football played in the month of August.

In addition to last year's opener vs. Archbishop Hoban (OH), Coach Vito Campanile's first game as Crusader head coach was an opening day win, August 31, 2018: a 34-22 victory over Grayson HS (GA).

The Crusaders hope to keep their undefeated August streak alive vs. Gibbons today.

CRUSADERS VS. SOUTHEAST USA

The Crusaders have mixed results with the Southeastern part of the country with a 5-3 record vs. teams from that part of the country.

Coach Nunzio Campanile led BC south starting in 2011 as BC travelled to Plant (FL) coming away with a 12-7 defeat. In 2012, Cocoa (FL) visited BC handing the Crusaders a 24-14 defeat. BC earned a forfeit victory over John Curtis (LA) after travelling to New Orleans and in 2014, BC defeated Bentonville HS (AR) in the land of Walmart 21-10.

The Crusaders thrashed American Heritage 37-7 in 2015 and then hosted IMG later that year. The Ascenders outscored BC 59-47 in Oradell. Christian Brother school, Tampa Catholic visited BC in 2016 and BC defeated their brother school 44-7.

The last loss came at the hands of BC's oldest rival, Don Bosco as the Ironmen shattered the Crusader hopes of an undefeated season, scoring on the final play of the game and converting the PAT for a 21-20 final.
