2022 BERGEN CATHOLIC CRUSADERS

The Crusaders enter today's game under the direction of Head Coach, Vito Campanile, the eleventh coach in program history. Coach Campanile has done nothing but polish an apple, leading the Crusaders to back-to-back #1 state rankings and a perfect 12-0 record with a #3 ranking in the USA by MaxPreps...the highest national ranking ever in school history.

VITO VENI VICI

Coach Campanile's record at the helm is now a gaudy 40-8 (.833 winning percentage) through his first four years at BC. His overall record as a head coach is 116-57 (.671) in 18 years where he spent time at Bergen Tech, Westwood and Seton Hall Prep. Coach Campanile led two state championship teams while at Westwood in 2013 and 2014.

THE CRUSADERS ON OFFENSE



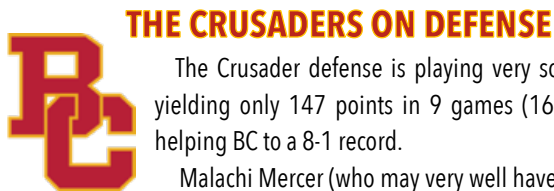
The Crusader Offense has been outstanding, posting 296 points on 3,113 total yards through nine games this year (345.9 yards per game). The Crusaders have now scored over 30 points in six of their nine games, averaging 32.9 points per game.

The Quarterback position has been highly productive all season despite the loss of Notre Dame QB, Steve Angeli to graduation last year. Senior Jack Duffy (#16) and Dominic Campanile (#17) have combined not only to execute a precise and secure attack, producing over 1400 yards and 15 touchdowns against only 3 interceptions. Campanile leads in TD passes (11) and yardage (784), but of his four, Duffy has thrown the longest TD (71 yards) and has over 600 yards under his belt.

Senior RB #7 Saeed St. Fleur leads BC in scoring with 13 rushing touchdowns and is a workhorse, grinding out opposing defenses for 1,320 yards so far this season, including 1071 on the ground. His 212 yard effort two weeks ago against Paramus Catholic was his highest yardage total in three years of varsity experience. It marked his first 200+ yard game and his sixth career 100+ yard game and fifth 100+ yard game this season. Saeed averages 6.1 yards per carry and shows he is just a big a threat out of the backfield as a receiver as he is a runner. When the Crusaders are near the endzone, there are just too many threats to deal with. Coach Campanile often inserts some of his defensive stalwarts like DJ Samuels and Sydir Mitchell to outman opponents and as a result, the red-zone offense has been very strong throughout the year.

Three additional very dangerous receiving threats will challenge the Griffins today. Sophomore sensation Quincy Porter leads the team in virtually every receiving category. The big #0 has 22 catches for 439 yards and 8 touchdowns. Porter has TD receptions in each of his last four games, six during that span. Christian Carti is second for the Crusaders with 19 receptions. The sure-handed senior has two touchdowns, including a dagger to SJR's chances in the second-quarter of the Great American Rivalry Series victory. Princeton-bound Jack Comeau has hauled in 15 passes for 287 yards and three touchdowns.

The Offensive line has helped the Crusaders put up overwhelming numbers against their opponents. BC's offense has generated 296 points so far this season because of the logistical relocation skills of Nyier Daniels, Owen Fernandez, Marcus Linder, Michael Gentilello, Sean Woods and Benji Shue. Dylan Garrity looked good in his return to a unit that is producing 3,113 yards (345.9ppg).



THE CRUSADERS ON DEFENSE

The Crusader defense is playing very solid football, yielding only 147 points in 9 games (16.3 ppg) and helping BC to a 8-1 record.

Malachi Mercer (who may very well have set a record with his 21-tackle game vs. Don Bosco) recorded another 15 tackles against Paramus Catholic. He leads the team with 88 tackles AND 4 interceptions from his middle linebacker position. Yale-bound linebacker, Joe Barry has 44 tackles and 4 TFLs and his three interceptions are third overall on the team. Christian Gonzales has sixty-nine tackles, five TFLs and one sack and a pair of interceptions.

The front four for the Crusaders has been strong, holding opponents to 94.3 rushing yards per game. Texas-bound Sydir Mitchell has recorded eleven tackles for a loss and four-and-a-half sacks. Teammate Elijah Kinsler also has 4.5 and to go with seven TFLs. Anthony Morales has nine TFLs and four sacks while Maryland-bound Samuels leads the team with 15 TFLs plus five sacks.

In the secondary a group of ball-hawkers who have 9 interceptions, will work to stifle the Donovan air attack. Junior safety Chris Mimmo turned an interception into a touchdown and has 38 tackles on the season, while talented sophomore corner Naiim Parrish leads the group with three picks on the season. Parrish also has 33 tackles, twenty-two of which are solo tackles (again leading the unit). Kaj Sanders has 34

tackles and a pair of TFLs plus an interception and senior corner Daquan Stewart has 25 tackles and a three picks of his own. Two of those were two weeks ago against PC. Don't be surprised to see sophomore nickel Anthony Perrotti make an impact on the game. He has a pick and a knack for finding the endzone when the ball is in his hands. Perrotti currently has 9 tackles and 4 passes defended.

BERGEN CATHOLIC SPECIAL TEAMS

Guyano Bartolomeo remains perfect on his execution with extra-points. The sophomore's 36 PATs is fifth among place kickers in the Super Football Conference, though among those 5, he is the only kicker who is perfect in his attempts to date. Fellow kicker, Carmelo Velardo, drove three extra-points through against PC and is 3 for 3 on the season. Carmelo has driven 18 of 49 kickoffs into the endzone for touchbacks. (36.7%)

While BC has not had very many opportunities to return kickoffs to date, sophomore Anthony Perrotti is very dangerous on the back-line with one KOR for a TD. The sophomore is averaging 29.0 yards per return on 10 returns to date. Chris Mimmo has 8 returns for 15.1 yards per return. Mimmo is also the team's punt returner, averaging 7 yards per return.

When BC punts, Brandon Arpacilar is entrusted with the task. The junior is averaging 31.5 yards per punt and a 29.4 yard net. Brandon drove his longest punt as a Crusader in the first quarter of last week's victory, a 62-yard bomb. Jack Duffy is able to pooch a ball inside the 20 at strategic point of a game.

2022 DONOVAN CATHOLIC GRIFFINS



The Griffins are coached by Dan Curcione. Coach Curcione has led the Griffins since 2017 and had an immediate positive impact on the program when he took over. From 0-10 the year prior to his commissioning, Curcione had the Griffins winning in year 1 and with a winning record in his second year.

In his six seasons at the helm, the Griffins are 38-20, good for a .655. His 2019 (9-2) and 2020 (7-1) teams were the winningest in DC football this millennium and his overall record is finer than any DC coach of recent memory.

Media sources have described this Donovan team as rebuilding, but make no mistake about it. They have every intention of making a big splash in their second trip to the Jack today.

THE GRIFFINS ON OFFENSE



Behind the center, expect to see reliable junior, (# 10) Todd Lambertson calling signals. More of a pocket passer and player who will beat you with his arm rather than his feet, he has completed over 56% of his passes for 1108 yards and 10 touchdowns against only two interceptions. Freshman (# 5) Zach Labarca had an opportunity to compete in three Griffins games this year. He completed his only pass of his high school career and it went 10 yards for a touchdown. Both young QBs will need to be decisive against a Crusader front-four that can wreak havoc on a passer that holds the ball too long.

Freshman (# 4) Najee Calhoun is the Griffins top rusher. He carried the ball 112 times for 592 yards, a 5.3 yard per carry average. The young man has two 100-yard games and has scored 10 touchdowns on the ground this year. Junior Roman Moyers (# 21) twelve carries for 153 yards has break-away speed and sophomore (# 26) Elijah Davis provides a nice compliment to Calhoun.

Michael Thomas, III (# 13) is Lambertson's favorite target. The sophomore has 38 receptions for 491 yards and four touchdowns. Freshman (# 18) Emanuel Gerena has hauled in 14 passes and averages over 15 yards per reception. He and Senior (# 1) Dante Vernieri and junior (# 6) Zaier Day each have a pair of touchdowns with the latter two grabbing 10 passes on the year.

THE GRIFFINS ON DEFENSE

Vernieri earns his money especially on the defensive side of the ball, where the senior leads the Griffs with 130 tackles on the year. Zaier Day is averaging over 10 tackles a game as well, racking up 83

on the season. The Crusaders will have to get juniors (# 30) Hunter Johnson, (# 23) JJ Correa and (# 21) Roman Moyers blocked. All three have over fifty tackles on the season.

THE GRIFFINS' SPECIAL TEAMS

Junior Dante Priolo (#19) handles the place kicking responsibilities for the Griffins. He has one touchback on the season and averages about 34 yards per kickoff. He is 20 of 25 in extra-point attempts and has not yet attempted a field goal this season.

Beware of the fake when the Donnies punt. Running back, Najee Calhoun (#4) is effective punting the ball (38.1 yards per punt), but in a game like this, everything is on the table.

NJSIAA PLAYOFFS: HOW WE GOT HERE

The Crusaders are the #2 seed in this year's Non-Public "A" Tournament. With only 14 qualifiers, BC and top-seeded Don Bosco Prep earned byes into the quarterfinal round.

The seventh-seeded Griffins defeated Hudson Catholic at home on Friday, November 4th 27-20.

Third-seeded St. Peter's Prep took care of business against fourteenth-seed, Notre Dame 57-22. They host sixth-seeded Delbarton defeated St. Joseph Metuchen 42-7. If the Crusaders win today, they will host with winner of this game on Saturday, November 19th at 1:00 PM.

Don Bosco hosts eighth-seeded St. Augustine Prep who unloaded on St. John Vianney 45-0 in their opening round game. The winner of that contest will play the winner of fourth-seeded St. Joseph Regional (who defeated Paul VI 45-20) and fifth-seeded Seton Hall Prep (who defeated Pope John XXIII 42-13).

CRUSADERS-GRIFFINS A VERY BRIEF HISTORY

The BC-DC rivalry spans one game over the course of two days. Bergen hosted the quarterfinal round game that was stopped due to lightning storms and ultimately a lack of daylight. Ultimately, the game that started on November 13, 2021 ended on November 14, 2021 with the Crusaders advancing to the state semifinals with a 35-7 victory.

THIS DAY IN BC FOOTBALL: NOVEMBER 12

The Crusaders are 5-1 overall on this day, dating back to their first victory over Queen of Peace in 1961. In 1983, BC played Paterson Kennedy in a hard-fought NNJIL victory. Bergen defeated Ridgewood for the first time in five years, 20-7 in Coach Fred Stengel's first season at the helm. Billy Tierney, Jimmy Finn and Joe and Jon Piela got the Crusader offense working which led to a 23-6 victory over the Bengal on Friday night at Foley Field.

The Crusaders suffered their only loss in their state playoff game against a determined Seton Hall Pirate Wing-T offense that churned out tremendous yardage and put 42 points up on BC.

Five years ago today, Coach Nunzio Campanile's offense threw up big numbers against St. Augustine Prep, defeating the Hermits 57-33 in the Non-Public "A" Quarterfinals.

CRUSADERS IN THE QUARTERS

Generally speaking, the Crusaders are a good bet in the Quarterfinals. Bergen is 18-4 overall in the quarters, an .818 winning percentage.

The first real quarterfinal round was not instituted until 1998, but the Crusaders played their first quarterfinal game in 1989, more on that in a moment. The early tournament was played in a Parochial "A" North format. There were four Parochial groups, "A" and "B" each in the North and South. In 1994, disparities in enrollment sizes were growing. In order to provide for more balanced playing-field, the NJSIAA broke the teams into state-wide Parochial 1-2-3-4, with Parochial 4 being among the largest schools. In recent years, playoff brackets are expanding and rather than just 8 teams qualifying, 16 may now compete for Parochial "A" and "B" state championships.



1989 was a bit of an outlier as more than 4 teams qualified for a playoff system designed for only four teams. The tournaments were seeded with only the top four power-point teams qualifying for the playoffs UNLESS a team outside those four was undefeated. Enter Delbarton. The Green Wave was unbeaten and entering as a 5-seed so the NJSIAA decided to include a sixth team, providing byes for both top

seeded St. Joseph Regional and second-seeded St. Peter's Prep. The Golden Griffins (not to be confused with the Donovan Catholic Griffins) edged Don Bosco Prep by .5 power points to earn the 6 seed. On a muddy football field, running a couple of successful tight-end rounds, the visitors were stopped by their inability to convert on their PATs while the Crusaders were perfect.

The 1998 Crusaders who defeated Bishop Ahr 41-0 on the first edition of FieldTurf at Crusader Stadium became the first 12-0 team in school history and was recognized by the Record as the Team of the Century. That was the first playoff game BC played at home on turf. Prior to that game, all other home games were on a natural grass quagmire, beloved to all who donned the scarlet and gold.

In 1999, the Crusaders led by Matt Lovecchio and Dominic Santoli earned the top seed in the tournament and earned a quarter-final round bye. 2013 was the first year since 1988 that BC did not qualify for the state playoffs, struggling through a 3-6 season.

IT'S AN HONOR!

Coach Campanile took the helm at Bergen Catholic in 2018, succeeding brother, Nunzio, who led BC to a state championship in 2017. Coach Vito immediately found success during the 2018 season, leading BC to the state final before the Crusaders were upset by St. Joseph Regional at MetLife Stadium.



Following a five-and-four 2019 campaign, Covid-19 prevented Campanile's #1-ranked Crusaders from pursuing a state championship as the state tournament was cancelled for the season.

In 2021, Coach Campanile led BC to its 18th state championship and second-ever 12-0 record. The Crusaders were the class of the state of New Jersey and earned the school's highest ever ranking to date of #3 in the country.

In recognition of his commitment to excellence and leadership, Coach Campanile was recognized by the **USAToday** as the Nation's High School Boys Coach of the Year.

In his fifth year at the helm of BC, Coach Campanile has a record of 35-7 (.833 winning percentage), one state championship and two #1 rankings in NJ. In his 16-year head coaching career, Coach Campanile has a record of 118-57 with a .674 winning percentage.
