2022 BERGEN CATHOLIC CRUSADERS

The Crusaders enter today's game under the direction of Head Coach, Vito Campanile, the eleventh coach in program history. Coach Campanile has done nothing but polish an apple, leading the Crusaders to back-to-back #1 state rankings and a perfect 12-0 record with a #3 ranking in the USA by MaxPreps...the highest national ranking ever in school history.

VITO VENI VICI

Coach Campanile's record at the helm is now a gaudy 40-8 (.833 winning percentage) through his first four years at BC. His overall record as a head coach is 116-57 (.671) in 18 years where he spent time at Bergen Tech, Westwood and Seton Hall Prep. Coach Campanile led two state championship teams while at Westwood in 2013 and 2014.

THE CRUSADERS ON OFFENSE



The Crusader Offense has been outstanding, posting 337 points on 3,519 total yards through nine games this year (351.9 yards per game). The Crusaders have now scored over 30 points in seven of their ten games, averaging 33.7 points per game.

Senior Jack Duffy (#16) had a terrific game in the first round game vs. Donovan Catholic. He connected for two touchdown passes to Quincy Porter, completing 8 of 10 passes for 115 yards. Sophomore QB, Dominic Campanile (#17) hit Dan Comeau for a TD and threw for 99 yards against the Griffins.

Together, Duffy and Campanile have completed 110 passes of 160 attempts for 1631 yards and 18 touchdowns.

Senior RB #7 Saeed St. Fleur leads BC in scoring with 13 rushing touchdowns and is a workhorse, grinding out opposing defenses for 1,379 yards so far this season, including 1121 on the ground. It marked his first 200+ yard game and his sixth career 100+ yard game and fifth 100+ yard game this season. Saeed averages 5.9 yards per carry and shows he is just a big threat out of the backfield as a receiver as he is a runner. Kaj Sanders is developing into a threat running the ball. With a 69 yard touchdown under his belt, he is averaging 8.6 yards per carry.

Sophomore sensation Quincy Porter leads the team in virtually every receiving category. The big #0 has 27 catches for 510 yards and 10 touchdowns. Porter has TD receptions in each of his last five games, eight during that span. Princeton-bound Jack Comeau has hauled in 23 passes for 418 yards and four touchdowns. Christian has 20 receptions. The sure-handed senior has two touchdowns, including a dagger to SJR's chances in the second-quarter of the Great American Rivalry Series victory.

The Offensive line has helped the Crusaders put up overwhelming numbers against their opponents. BC's offense has generated 296 points so far this season because of the logistical relocation skills of Nyier Daniels, Owen Fernandez, Marcus Linder, Michael Gentilello, Sean Woods and Benji Shue. Dylan Garrity looked good in his return to a unit that is producing nearly 200 yards on the ground per game (1876 yards).

THE CRUSADERS ON DEFENSE



The Crusader defense is coming off its fourth game of holding the opponent to a touchdown or less.

Malachi Mercer recorded eight tackles against Donovan Catholic. He leads the team with 96 tackles and has 4 interceptions from his middle linebacker position. Ethan Cohall was in on eight tackles and Yale-bound linebacker, Joe Barry has 7 tackles including 2.5 TFLs and 1 sack. He has 51 tackles and 3 interceptions on the year. Christian Gonzales has 74 tackles, second overall on the team.

The front four for the Crusaders will be tested by a strong running Green Wave team. Run defense has not necessarily been the strength of this unit, that is yielding 105.7 yards per game on the ground. They are able to pursue the passer, however and have contributed to 21 sacks on the year.

In the secondary a group of ball-hawkers who have 9 interceptions, will work to stifle the Donovan air attack. Naiim Parrish leads the group with five picks on the season. He and Kaj Sanders each intercepted two passes against Donovan Catholic and each returned one for a touchdown.

BERGEN CATHOLIC SPECIAL TEAMS

Guytano Bartolomeo's streak of 40 consecutive PAT's was broken when he missed his fifth attempt vs. Donovan Catholic. He made his last kick and now stands at 41 for 42 on the season and 1 of 2 on field goal attempts. Fellow kicker, Carmelo Velardo, drove three extra-points through against PC and is 3 for 3 on the season. He sent four kicks into

the endzone for touchbacks against Donovan. On the season he has driven 22 of 56 kickoffs into the endzone for touchbacks. (38.3%)

While BC has not had very many opportunities to return kickoffs to date, sophomore Anthony Perrotti is very dangerous on the back-line with one KOR for a TD. The sophomore is averaging 29.0 yards per return on 10 returns to date. Chris Mimmo has 9 returns for 15.6 yards per return. Mimmo is also the team's punt returner, averaging 7 yards per return.

When BC punts, Brandon Arpacilar is entrusted with the task. The junior is averaging 31.5 yards per punt and a 29.4 yard net. Brandon's longest punt was a 62-yard bomb vs. Paramus Catholic. Jack Duffy is able to pooch a ball inside the 20 at strategic point of a game.

2022 DELBARTON GREEN WAVE



Since starting the season 0-3, the Green Wave has won 6 of its last 8 games, with their two opening round victories in the playoffs coming in impressive fashion. Most eye-opening about Coach Brian Bowers' bunch is their complete result reversal against St. Peter's Prep in the state quarterfinals. Caven Point is a difficult place to play on the road and it gave the Wave difficulties in their week 3 loss to the Marauders. The team went to school and righted the ship with a 35-12 pounding of the third-seeded Jersey Citians.

Over the last twenty years at the helm, Coach Bowers has built a strong program that is capable of beating any team on any given Saturday. His 144-67 overall record is quite impressive, boasting a .682 winning percentage. Coach Bowers has led teams to four state championship games, coming up just short of the title in each attempt. He is hoping to lead his team through Oradell to southern Bergen County for next week's big one at MetLife Stadium.

THE GREEN WAVE ON OFFENSE

Luke Vidaic '23 – contributor



The Green Wave's starting quarterback is, (#7) Robert Russo '23. He passed for more than 3,000 yards with 30 touchdowns over the last two seasons. He has reduced the number of interceptions he's thrown from 8 in 2021 to 3 this season. He should have plenty of time to throw the ball and create plays with an experienced offensive line.

Delbarton's most dangerous offensive weapon is (#5) Ryan Trafford. Trafford's first season of varsity football has accumulated 20 touchdowns, (18 rushing). He is averaging 135 scrimmage yards per game over 11 games (1,490 yards). This junior receiving back is the key to Delbarton's offense, accounting for another 287 yards out of the backfield and two more touchdowns. Brock Dandridge has explosive speed, rushing for 232 yards with three touchdowns including a 93-yard burst.

To complement a strong backfield, Delbarton has a strong corps of receivers. In addition to Trafford, three receivers have over 200 yards receiving this season. This includes senior, (#3) J.P. Cafasso (20 catches for 224 yards), (#19) Austin Kivlar (26 for 202 yards), and their star-receiving sophomore (#1) Philip Folmar (36 for 440, 7 TDs yards). Philip has 440 yards receiving and 7 touchdowns. Philip Folmar will be a big threat in the coming years averaging 12.2 yards per reception.

THE GREEN WAVE ON DEFENSE

Junior Linebackers Dallas Hurley (#4) and Johnny Riley (#33) co-lead the Green Wave with 76 tackles on the season. Son of a BC alum, Connor Martin (#81) is leading the green wave in sacks with 2.5. He has 61 tackles on the season and 8 TFLs. Linebacker Jack Eisenhardt (#16) has a pair of interceptions for the Green Wave and 71 tackles during his senior campaign.

THE GREEN WAVE SPECIAL TEAMS

Senior Kicker Jack Peros (#10) is 39 for 40 on PATs in 2022. He's made 5 of 9 field goals this year. In his career, Petros is 52 for 55 on extra-points and 8 for 13 on field goals.

NJSIAA PLAYOFFS: HOW WE GOT HERE

This week is the NJSIAA Non-Public, Group A State Tournament Semi-finals. The second-seeded Crusaders (9-1) take on the sixth-seeded Green Wave (6-5). On the other side of the bracket, top-seeded Don Bosco Ironmen (8-2) faces fifth-seeded Seton Hall Prep's Pirates (6-5). The winners of these games will be heading to MetLife Stadium in East Rutherford next Friday night at 6:00 PM to play for the State Championship.

ROUND ONE: Don Bosco and Bergen Catholic earned byes through the first round.

On the top half of the bracket, eighth seed, St. Augustine won in dominant fashion 45-0, defeating St. John Vianney to advance to the quarters. Fifth-seed Seton Hall proved to be too much for Pope John XXIII as they won 42-13 against the 12th seeded Lions. Fourth seeded St. Joseph Regional defeated Paul VI 45-13 to move onto the quarter finals.

Third-seeded St. Peter's Prep's offense was on a roll as they exploded to a 57-22 victory over fourteenth-seed Notre Dame. This was the single highest scoring game by a team in the playoffs so far. Six seed Delbarton beat St. Joe's Metuchen 42-6 to advance and seventh seeded Donovan Catholic edged out Hudson Catholic in a back and forth game that would end in a 27-20 victory for the Griffins.

QUARTERFINALS: Don Bosco, the number 1 seed in this year's bracket, defeated 8th seeded St. Augustine with the final score being 37-0. Seton Hall Prep recorded a huge upset victory, scoring a touchdown with 7 seconds in regulation to come from behind. They defeated 4th seeded St. Joseph's Regional, 34-30 to advance to reach semi-finals.

Second seeded Bergen Catholic, is coming off a dominant win against Donovan Catholic. The Crusaders won 41-7. Sixth-seeded Delbarton pulled off the second big upset win of the tournament. They defeated number 3 seed, Marauders of Saint Peter's Prep. Delbarton won 35-12 going away and advance to today's game vs. BC in the semi-finals.

The stage for the semi-finals is now set. Seton Hall played in Ramsey against Don Bosco Prep last night. Delbarton is facing the Crusaders today at The Jack in Oradell.

CRUSADERS vs. GREEN WAVE HISTORY

The first time the Crusaders and Green Wave ever faced off against each other was on December 2, 2001. It happened to be in the biggest game of the year, the Non-Public "4" State Final. Coach Fred Stengel's Crusaders won their eighth state title under his tutelage, defeating Delbarton 10-9, a game decided ultimately by one missed extra point.

Interestingly enough, earlier in the year, the Crusaders lost to Don Bosco Prep 14-13 after the BC extra point was blocked with one second remaining on the clock. BC had made a furious comeback, scoring two touchdowns in the final minute and a half of the game, but it was not enough. In the state semi-finals, Don Bosco played Delbarton and lost 14-13. Again, one missed extra-point was the difference.

After their first game, the Crusaders and Green Wave did not play each other for 16 years. The second time the two teams played each other was

on Nov 18, 2017 in the state semi-final game. The Crusaders picked up another win against the Green Wave, blowing them out 41-16.

BC defeated the Wave in 2021 (28-19) and in 2022 (21-6).

THIS DAY IN BC FOOTBALL: NOV 19

The Crusaders are 4-1 overall on this day, dating back to their first victory over Essex in 1966. The most recent four contests were all playoff games, three in the semi-finals and the 2011 game taking place in the quarterfinal round.

In 1966, the Crusaders ran wild at Schools Stadium in Newark, rushing for 433 vs. Essex Catholic's Eagles. Fullback Joe Hoats ran for 222 yards and two touchdowns in the Crusaders' wing-t attack. Other scorers were QB, Mike Purchia (1 TD), Bart Travaglio (1 TD), Bob Kunz (1 TD) and John Paoella (1 TD). Phil King booted two extra points and Dave Crifasi scored a two-point conversion in the 39-21 victory.

1977: Mike Pecoraro scored three touchdowns, leading BC to a 30-0 semifinal victory over St. Joseph Regional. The Crusaders advanced to play Seton Hall Prep in the state finals. They would first face Thanksgiving Rival, Don Bosco Prep five days later. John Rice, Joe Hughes and Jim McDonell all starred defensively for the Crusaders in the shutout.

CRUSADERS IN THE SEMIFINALS

Since the state playoff system began in 1974, BC has played in 43 tournaments, reaching the finals thirty times. The Crusaders have been dominant in the semi-final round of the state tournament. Bergen is 29-9 overall, good for a winning percentage of 76.3. Today marks the second time BC is playing Delbarton in a semi-finals. The last time these two teams met in the playoffs was at Bergen in 2017 with the Crusaders taking a 41-16 decision. That year Bergen was ranked 20th in the nation and finished their season as state champions with a record of 10-2 under the direction of Coach Nunzio Campanile.

Bergen's first ever semi-final game was against Seton Hall Prep in 1975 with the Crusaders beating the Pony-Pirates 7-6. That started an eight-game semi-finals win streak as the Crusaders defeated SJR in 1977, Queen of Peace in '78, SJR in '79, DePaul in '80, Immaculata in '81 and Marist in both '82 and '84. The Crusaders reached the state finals in 1983 as only 2 teams, BC and Don Bosco Prep qualified that season.

The Crusaders highest scoring Semi-final game was also against Seton Hall on Sat Nov 20, 2010. Bergen crushed them with a final score of 60-17. Tanner McEvoy completed 9 of 17 passes for 163 yards with 3 TDs. He also rushed for 184 yards and 2 TDs to lead them to the state championship game against Don Bosco Prep.

The Crusaders have scored over 30 points 17 times in 38 games in the semi-finals. Defensively, the Crusaders have been strong, earning 10 shutouts vs. 8 separate opponents. Shutout victims: St. Joseph Regional (1977, 1986), Queen of Peace (1978), DePaul (1980), Immaculata (1981, 1992), Marist (1984), Don Bosco Prep (1987), Notre Dame (1996), St. Augustine Prep (2008). In addition, the Crusaders have yielded one touchdown or less 15 times in semi-final history.

BC's most-played and most dangerous opponent in the semi-final round has been St. Peter's Prep. The Marauders hold a 5-3 advantage over BC in 8 games. Next is Don Bosco Prep. Bergen is 4-2 in six attempts vs. the Ironmen, then comes St. Joseph Regional (3-1), Notre Dame (3-0), Holy Cross (3-0), Seton Hall Prep (2-1), Marist (2-0), Holy Spirit (1-0), DePaul (1-0), St. Augustine Prep (1-0), Delbarton (1-0), Paramus Catholic (1-0) and Queen of Peace (1-0).

IT'S AN HONOR!

Coach Campanile took the helm at Bergen Catholic in 2018, succeeding brother, Nunzio, who led BC to a state championship in 2017. Coach Vito immediately found success during the 2018 season, leading BC to the state final before the Crusaders were upset by St. Joseph Regional at MetLife Stadium.



Following a five-and-four 2019 campaign, Covid-19 prevented Campanile's #1-ranked Crusaders from pursuing a state championship as the state tournament was cancelled for the season.

In 2021, Coach Campanile led BC to its 18th state championship and second-ever

12-0 record. The Crusaders were the class of the state of New Jersey and earned the school's highest ever ranking to date of #3 in the country.

In recognition of his commitment to excellence and leadership, Coach Campanile was recognized by the **USA Today** as the Nation's High School Boys Coach of the Year.

In his fifth year at the helm of BC, Coach Campanile has a record of 35-7 (.833 winning percentage), one state championship and two #1 rankings in NJ. In his 16-year head coaching career, Coach Campanile has a record of 118-57 with a .674 winning percentage.
