BIRD OF THE WEEK CAROLINA WREN

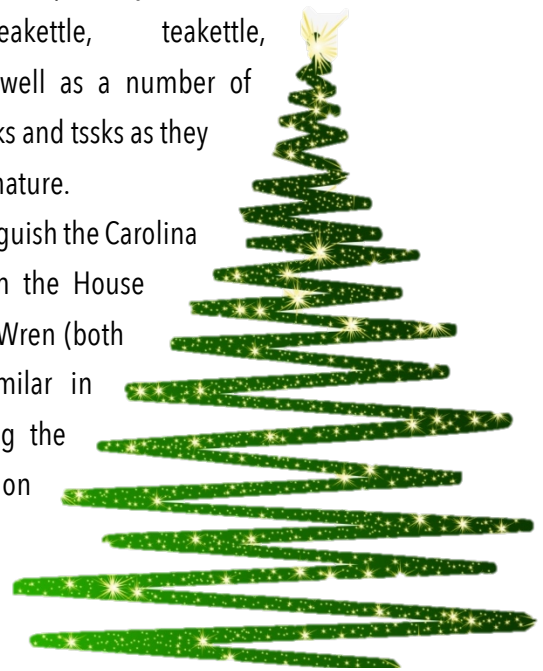


December 23 - Hillsdale, NJ - It was the first bird of the morning for me today as I looked out the window at my feeder.

Wrens have a distinct shape with their small, brown bodies and upward arching bill and tail (generally). They have a distinctive and unexpectedly loud call. It's a cheerful, "teakettle, teakettle, teakettle..." as well as a number of threatening chicks and tsks as they are territorial in nature.

You can distinguish the Carolina wren easily from the House Wren or Winter Wren (both smaller, but similar in shape) by noting the white eyebrow on this bird.

They generally hold their tail up, displaying black banding on the tail.

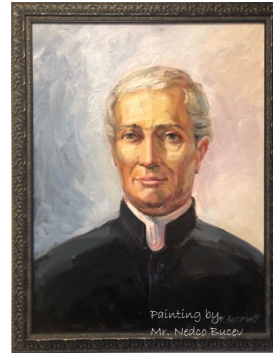

How to Pray the Rosary

1. Make the Sign of the Cross.
2. Holding the Crucifix, say the *Apostles' Creed*.
3. On the first bead, say an *Our Father*.
4. Say one *Hail Mary* on each of the next three beads.
5. Say the *Glory Be*
6. For each of the five decades, announce the Mystery (perhaps followed by a brief reading from Scripture) then say the *Our Father*.
7. While fingering each of the ten beads of the decade, next say ten Hail Marys while meditating on the Mystery. Then say a *Glory Be*. (After finishing each decade, some say the following prayer requested by the Blessed Virgin Mary at Fatima: *O my Jesus, forgive us our sins, save us from the fires of hell; lead all souls to Heaven, especially those who have most need of your mercy.*)
8. After saying the five decades, say the Hail, Holy Queen, followed by this dialogue and prayer:
V. Pray for us, O holy Mother of God.
R. That we may be made worthy of the promises of Christ.

Let us pray: O God, whose Only Begotten Son, by his life, Death, and Resurrection, has purchased for us the rewards of eternal life, grant, we beseech thee, that while meditating on these mysteries of the most holy Rosary of the Blessed Virgin Mary, we may imitate what they contain and obtain what they promise, through the same Christ our Lord. Amen.
