December 28 - Wayne, NJ - Brayden Kane scored two even goals in the second period to keep BC in the fight vs. Don Bosco Prep.



BIRD OF THE WEEK

PAINTED BUNTING

December 30 - Lower Township, NJ - Two and a half hours. Not fun. Actually, it was. We were standing there talking, staring at a bird feeder with nothing on it.

I arrived at 11:30 am on December 29 and remained until 2:10 pm.



Now for the choice. Do I quit or stay? I really hated the possibility of investing that much time into finding a bird and not finding it, but it wouldn't be the first time and I'm sure it won't be the last.

Stay.

Expedia was a big help, but the discount motel I attempted to stay at was not. How do you not have access to e-mail? What year is this?

Fortunately, Expedia picked up the difference as they found me a new motel and I was in business. Early the next day, I arose and was first at the feeder, including birds. As I watched, a neighbor drove by and said, "Oh, that bird's long gone by now."

Ha ha. I was not discouraged. A couple from Sayreville arrived. We spoke about our attempts (actually their success and my attempts) at finding the Stellar's Sea Eagle earlier in the year in Maine.



Success! At 8:30, we finally saw the bird, but it was in a distant yard on someone's property who did not care for birders trespassing. We respected that begrudgingly.

The bird was far away and through a wrought-iron fence which played havoc with my automatic focus. But alas, now to the top of a tree and finally flying directly over our heads and to the backyard of the house we were waiting at.

More waiting. Finally at about 10:40, a second sighting provided these photos. More people from around the state. I reacquainted with an elderly from Woodbridge with whom I saw my 1st Garganey in Monmouth County. Also, the couple who returned after striking out with me the day before.

The thing about it is, Painted Buntings are rare in the northeast. You are far more likely to find them south of the border or in Texas, Florida to South Carolina in the winters. Females are almost entirely the greenish color of the male, so I prefer to see the male (like this one).

The last time I encountered one was December 5, 2015 in Prospect Park, Brooklyn, NY. Will Ferrell was there in his Elf suit with some kind of an Elf 5K run, but we found this bird surrounded by about 50 admirers. HAPPY NEW YEAR!



How to Pray the Rosary

1. Make the Sign of the Cross.
2. Holding the Crucifix, say the *Apostles' Creed*.

4. Say one *Hail Mary* on each of the next three beads.
5. Say the *Glory Be*
6. For each of the five decades, announce the Mystery (perhaps followed by a brief reading from Scripture) then say the *Our Father*.
7. While fingering each of the ten beads of the decade, next say ten Hail Marys while meditating on the Mystery. Then say a *Glory Be*. (After finishing each decade, some say the following prayer requested by the Blessed Virgin Mary at Fatima: *O my Jesus, forgive us our sins, save us from the fires of hell; lead all souls to Heaven, especially those who have most need of your mercy.*)
8. After saying the five decades, say the Hail, Holy Queen, followed by this dialogue and prayer:
V. Pray for us, O holy Mother of God.
R. That we may be made worthy of the promises of Christ.

Let us pray: O God, whose Only Begotten Son, by his life, Death, and Resurrection, has purchased for us the rewards of eternal life, grant, we beseech thee, that while meditating on these mysteries of the most holy Rosary of the Blessed Virgin Mary, we may imitate what they contain and obtain what they promise, through the same Christ our Lord.
