# BIRD OF THE WEEK WHITE CROWNED SPARROW

**January 7 - Lyndhurst, NJ -** There comes a point in a person's life when they need to grow up and work to identify



sparrows. It's not exciting. It's not sexy. They're typically just little brown jobs popping around on the ground, but they separate top birders from others.

White-crowned sparrows do not have the conspicuous Yellow patches above the eyes on the WTSP. It does not have a white throat, either. Mature sparrows do have three white stripes crowning their heads, separated by two black stripes. The throat and breast are light gray and their backs are brownish and similar to that of many sparrows.

THIS is the bird that is likely NOT at your feeder. The White-Crowned Sparrow is slightly different than the white-THROATED sparrow that frequents the ground near feeders at this time of year. # How to Pray the Rosary

- 6. For each of the five decades, announce the Mystery (perhaps followed by a brief reading from Scripture) then say the *Our Father*.
- 7. While fingering each of the ten beads of the decade, next say ten Hail Marys while meditating on the Mystery. Then say a Glory Be.

  (After finishing each decade, some say the following prayer requested by the Blessed Virgin Mary at Fatima: O my Jesus, forgive us our sins, save us from the fires of hell; lead all souls to Heaven, especially those who have most need of your mercy.)
- 8. After saying the five decades, say the Hail, Holy Queen, followed by this dialogue and prayer:V. Pray for us, O holy Mother of God.R. That we may be made worthy of the promises of Christ.

Let us pray: O God, whose Only Begotten Son, by his life, Death, and Resurrection, has purchased for us the rewards of eternal life, grant, we beseech thee, that while meditating on these mysteries of the most holy Rosary of the Blessed Virgin Mary, we may imitate what they contain and obtain what they promise, through the same Christ our Lord. Amen.
