

LBHEs generally reflect beautiful cobalt blues and various shades of blue and violet depending upon the sunlight. It's probably the reason they are so attractive for birders. Other species can be colorful, but for whatever reason I really like this species.

A good place to see little blue herons as well as other species of herons including Great Blue Heron, Black Crowned Night-heron, Yellow-Crowned Night-heron, Tri-colored Heron, Great Egret, Snowy Egret, Glossy Ibis and White Ibis is at the Visitor Center on the causeway into Ocean City. If you are travelling down to Cape May County in the late spring or early summer, stop in to see this rookery where dozens if not hundreds of birds roost, lay eggs and feed their young before they fledge the nest.



### How to Pray the Rosary

- 1. Make the Sign of the Cross.

- 7. While fingering each of the ten beads of the decade, next say ten Hail Marys while meditating on the Mystery. Then say a *Glory Be*. (After finishing each decade, some say the following prayer requested by the Blessed Virgin Mary at Fatima: O my Jesus, forgive us our sins, save us from the fires of hell; lead all souls to Heaven, especially those who have most need of your mercy.)
- 8. After saying the five decades, say the Hail, Holy Queen, followed by this dialogue and prayer:V. Pray for us, O holy Mother of God.R. That we may be made worthy of the promises of Christ.

Let us pray: O God, whose Only Begotten Son, by his life, Death, and Resurrection, has purchased for us the rewards of eternal life, grant, we beseech thee, that while meditating on these mysteries of the most holy Rosary of the Blessed Virgin Mary, we may imitate what they contain and obtain what they promise, through the same Christ our Lord. Amen.
