Hunter DeBellis (Volleyball) and Tim Downey (Rugby) bring enthusiasm and expertise to lead these exciting programs.

## ALUMNUS TIM DOWNEY EARNS NOD TO LEAD RUGBY PROGRAM

**January 29 - Oradell, NJ** - Alumnus, Tim Downey is returning to his alma mater to become its Varsity Rugby Coach this coming spring.



Downey began head coaching at Iona College in New Rochelle, NY where he served as

Head Coach in 2011-12. He became an Assistant at his college alma mater from 2012 and still serves the college in that role. Downey took the reins of the SUNY New Paltz Men's Rugby program in 2021, but chose to return to Bergen to build young men through his passion for the game.

Downey has extensive experience working with professional, youth and high school players and is a certified referee who mentors and coaches officials new to the sport.

When you ask Tim what he does, he has a one-word response, "Rugby." From individual and team coaching to officiating, time-keeping or serving as a leader in various rugby organization capacities, there's a good chance you'll find Coach Tim involved.

He continues to serve as the NYAC Under-25 All-Star team, a role he has held since 2020.

Success? Coach Tim's teams have placed 5<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> in the Collegiate Rugby Championships. While at Iona, his teams

won two Beast of the East Championships and three Four-Leaf titles.

## HUNTER DEBELLIS TO LEAD SPIKERS

**January 29 - Oradell, NJ** - If the name sounds familiar, it should. DeBellis has been synonymous with BC Football for well over 30 years. This year, Coach Tony DeBellis '85, will see his daughter, Hunter, take the reins of the Crusader Volleyball program.

## SWIMMERS TAKE FIRST BERGEN COUNTY TITLE SINCE 2017

**January 21-22 - Nyack, NY** - In the final event of the night, Bergen Catholic's 200 FR of Eric Yoo, Raymond Stelmark, Doyee Kim and Gavin Perez posted a time of 3:11.80 to edge out Tenafly for the county title.



Bergen Catholic finished with 256 points, while Tenafly (241) and Demarest (142) rounded out the top three.

Bergen Catholic notched three additional first-place victories to seal its 7th overall county title, with Doyee Kim winning the 200 IM (1:54.26), Raymond Stelmark capturing the 500 free title (4:37.77), and the 200 FR of Rhyse Ruffy, Dimtri Melnikov, Yoo and Perez posting a winning time of 1:29.53.

"We scored it out based on the psych sheets," Kunnapas said. "We knew that it would be within 10 points. So we knew it was going to be close in every race, so every place was going to count. Tenafly is very good. We didn't start off the meet as well as we wanted to, but we definitely rebounded. Winning that relay was a nice way to go out."

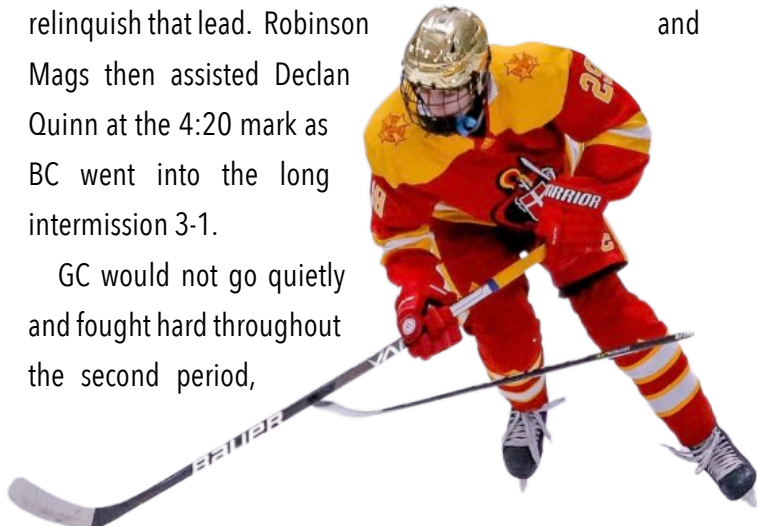
### GLOUCESTER CATHOLIC

## DECISIONS NOT ENOUGH AS BC WIN STREAK ENDS

**January 25 - Oradell, NJ** - For the first time in any of our



current student's lifetimes, BC lost to St. Joseph Regional in wrestling. The Crusaders carried a 25-year, 20 match streak against the

Green Knights as well as a 22-match winning streak (tied for the longest in school history) into Wednesday's match. Both streaks were snapped as an impassioned Green Knight crew defeated BC 34-21.

As a result, SJR and BC swapped state ranking positions (#2-#3), likely seeds in the state tournament (#2-#3) and the Green Knights clinched the BNC United Division title.

The match started at 120 pounds with Brian Melamud earning a 4-2 victory. Noah Kochman opened his 126-pound bout with a five-point move (two points for a takedown and three back points for a near fall). His opponent was ultimately able to avoid being pinned and avoid yielding an additional team point by losing only by 6 points as BC led 6-0. August Hibler (138 lbs) and Aidan Wallace (157 lbs) each earned victories of 6 point differentials as well, but BC was never able to earn bonus points in their victories.

## THE MAN IN THE ARENA

**January 29 - Oradell, NJ** - Some quotations are timeless.

That certainly is true about this quote extracted from

President Theodore Roosevelt's speech: "Citizenship in a Republic" at the Sorbonne Paris, France on April 23, 1910.



So much of today's culture reacts immediately, choosing to whip out a cellphone to frame a moment, rather than jump into the arena. It is quick to engage

in presentism, evaluating historical events using today's standards.



This quote is for all of our students and student-athletes who have the courage to jump into the fray. It goes out to all of our members of the community who do more than just "talk about it." They serve communities in need. They get involved. They don't create excuses or apologize for what they do. There is no need. This is for all of those guys who compete when sick, who compete when injured, who lose weight or step up when someone is injured to fill their place.

*It is not the critic who counts; not the man who points out how the strong man stumbles, or where the doer of deeds could have done them better. The credit belongs to the man who is actually in the arena, whose face is marred by dust and sweat and blood; who strives valiantly; who errs, who comes short again and again, because there is no effort without error and shortcoming; but who does actually strive to do the deeds; who knows great enthusiasms, the great devotions; who spends himself in a worthy cause; who at the best knows in the end the triumph of high achievement, and who at the worst, if he fails, at least fails while daring greatly, so that his place shall never be with those cold and timid souls who neither know victory nor defeat.*

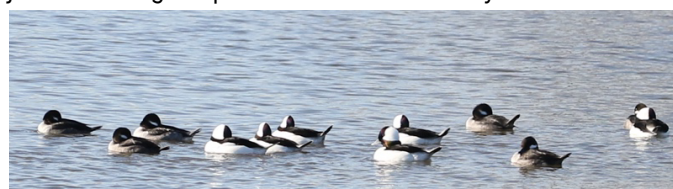

## BIRD OF THE WEEK BUFFLEHEAD

**January 29 - Lyndhurst, NJ** - I was unable to get a good photo of a Eurasian Wigeon, which is a rare bird around these parts, so I'm substituting one of my favorite ducks, the Bufflehead. So you know, I saw and counted the EUWI, but just couldn't get a photo that I found worthy of YOU!



Buffleheads are small diving ducks. Unlike dabbling ducks (like mallards, American Black Ducks, Northern Pintails and Northern Shovelers) buffleheads dive for their food below the surface. They generally feed on aquatic invertebrates (underwater animals that do not have a spine) as they pop up and down in the water in search of food.

Their large heads are a glossy green and purple and they have white bodies which easily distinguishes them from another small diver, the hooded Merganser.

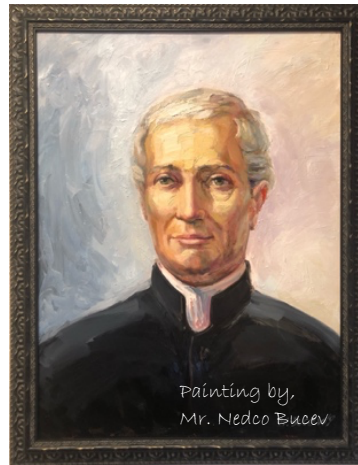
