TONIGHT'S MATCH-UP

For the fifth time, the Crusaders and Bulldogs meet on the hard court in fine Bergen County Basketball. This very occasional rivalry began a quarter century ago in the County Jamboree.

CRUSADERS: BC is returning home following a split in the prestigious Quincy Shootout in Illinois. Terry Copeland scored 35 points combined as a number of players stepped up around national talent. Bergen had a trifecta of 13s scored by Austin Spencer, Brandon Benjamin and Naiim Parrish in Bergen's first game against Nebraska's Millard North High School. In the second game, it was Copeland's 17 leading again, this time against Wasatch Academy of Utah. Tyler McQuaid (12 points), David Munro (7 points) and Benjamin (6 points) provided much of the remaining offense. The Crusaders look forward to the return of Chidi Nwigwe who was unable to compete over the weekend.

BULLDOGS: Dwight Englewood has had a rough go of it lately, dropping their fourth straight game against St. Mary's of Rutherford on Sunday (55-49). Things will get no easier for this K-9 crew against a Bergen team that hopes to heat up going into the Bergen County Jamboree.

This Day in Crusader Basketball JANUARY 24, 1973 - NEW CITY, NY

Fifty years ago today, the Crusaders beat Clarkstown North 63-59 in a game that was closely played throughout. Tied early at 4, the Rams' Tom Holstein scored four in a 6-point run to give the home team a 10-4 lead. This lead was short-lived, however, as Jim Hopkins and company worked to give BC a 17-16 lead after one quarter.

Hopkins was outstanding at the free-throw line, where he scored nine of his 17 points. Jimmy Moye and Greg Sheerins each scored team-high18 points.

The win helped BC to reach 10-4 on the season. Bergen was on its way to a very fine 19-6 overall record under Coach Chris "CJ" Donfield.
