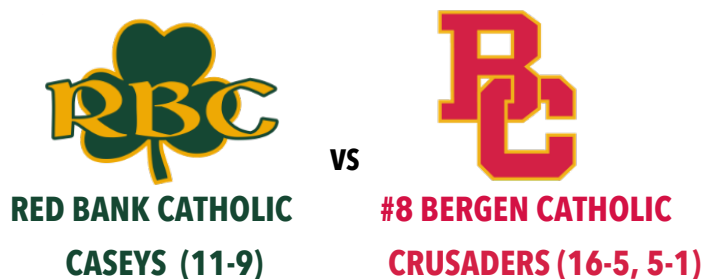

THIS AFTERNOON'S MATCH-UP

The Crusaders and Caseys meet for only the second time in the two schools' basketball histories. Their first meeting was 364 days ago in Red Bank when the Crusaders took a 68-48 decision. The Caseys are looking to even their record against their host today at Hoehl Gymnasium.

CRUSADERS: BC is on a four-game winning streak. The youthful scarlet and gold team has won a pair of Bergen County Jamboree contests and two BNC United Division games. They are hoping that they continue to build momentum going into Tuesday night's clash with Don Bosco Prep.

Brandon Benjamin is continuing to dominate the offensive and defensive boards and Terry Copeland is starting to stretch defenses, scoring quite a number of threes from down town. Youth is maturing before our eyes, especially players like Chidi Nwigwe, Naiim Parrish and Julius Advent who are making the most of their minutes.

CASEYS: Three to watch: Junior Tyler Burnham(#55) leads the Caseys in points (294) and rebounds (191). Junior Guard (#0) leads the team with 35 steals and has 276 points. Sophomore G/F Ryan Prior (#22) is making an impact with 233 points and 137 rebounds.

RBC is averaging 62.3 points per game on offense and holds opponents to 52.4 per game.

Twenty-five years ago, the Crusaders defeated Barringer's Blue Bears 77-68 to improve to 18-1 on the season. Pat Nagle knocked down six three-pointers and Mark Jerz added four as the Crusaders opened up a 19-point lead in the third quarter, outscoring the Blue Bears by 11.
