February 7 - Wayne, NJ - The Crusaders took on previously undefeated Northern Highlands in the BCCA Semifinals on Monday evening. The Crusaders opened a 3-0 lead before the #2 seed came roaring back.

The Highlanders scored two goals before BC added one to go up 4-2 into the third period. Highlands recorded a pair of third period goals to send the game to overtime before Tommy Keough hit a backhand over the goalie's stick side shoulder for the deciding goal.

The Crusader set the pace with Declan Quinn opening the scoring off assists by Cory Robinson and Jacob Carver. Robinson then made the score 2-0 with Matt Maglio and Quinn playing the roles of set-up men. Niko Smilovic scored goal #3 for Bergen as Max Wright got into the action, setting Smilovic up with help from Maglio.

Robinson scored his second goal of the evening with DQ setting him late in the second period. The BC offense was unable to generate any offense in their one power play and the Crusaders killed off two of three short-handed situations. Ryan Henry saved 23 shots to earn the victory.

February 11 - Hackensack, NJ - The Crusader Bowling Team won its first Sectional title in thirteen years led by 600+ pin series by seniors Liam Chin and Justin Martin.



It was an outstanding effort as the two leaders both qualified for the individual state championship tournament. John Brignola and Andy Lee were just two and one pins off the mark to qualify respectively.



Lee and Martin each rolled 211s in the opening game to help BC to a first game total of 970 pins. Liam Chin then rolled the team's high game of 237 in Game 2 and Bergen finished with a 993. Lee was high scorer in game three,

McQUAID, BENJAMIN HELP AVENGE EARLY SEASON DEFEAT BC CRUISES TO JAMBO FINAL

February 11 - Hackensack, NJ - Shortly after the Bowling team won the NJSIAA Group IV North Sectional Title, the basketball team did its job in the county seat, defeating Ramapo 71-57 in the Jamboree Semifinal Round.



It was one of those days where you needed to beat the eight guys on the court as BC racked up the first six fouls of the game against none by the immaculate Green Raiders. No problem. BC was smart and under control for the entire 32 minutes of play, consistently out-positioning and out-working their opponents.

The Crusaders went with Tyler McQuaid, Naiim Parrish and Mikai Klintman along with big men Brandon Benjamin and Terry Copeland to start. The quintet worked well together, especially on defense, where they were able to switch effectively on picks up top and get hands in front of outside shooters, where the Raiders were especially dangerous.

McQuaid led the Crusaders in scoring early through the game, finishing with 15 points. He had a difficult task of defending Ramapo's 6'4 top scorer which he did a fine job.



Brandon Benjamin was the Crusaders top scorer with a team-high, seventeen points. Brandon's athleticism and hustle was on full-display as he worked for great position under the boards, but also created fast break opportunities on offense. It did not end there, however. Benjamin really opened some eyes with some demonstrative blocks and a sprint down court to contest a break-away lay-up where most players would have given up on the play well-before.

David Munro used his 6-7 frame similarly to Benjamin coming off the bench. Another guy who can really cover ground, David contributed eight points to the effort as well.

Jaylen Robinson and Austin Spencer gave some excellent minutes off the bench as BC took its 11-point lead into the third quarter.

While Ramapo cut into it by a basket, they were never able to make much of a run until the very end of the game when they prevented the score from being an 18-point Crusader victory.
