### BERGEN – BOSCO IV BENJAMIN GOES OFF CRUSADERS ADVANCE

**February 27 – Ramsey, NJ –** Press all over and Score 100!

That was the vision and that was the way BC played all over the hardwood at Don Bosco Prep on Monday night. In an inspired night, junior forward Brandon Benjamin won the opening tip and scored a team-high 25 points to go with his 12 rebounds, 2 blocks and 2 steals. 18 of those 25 points came from four first half three pointers and three field goals that helped the Crusaders open a 42-25 first half lead.

It wasn't so much that the Ironmen were playing poorly. It was much more that the Crusaders were flying around the court and dominating. Sophomore guard Tyler McQuaid scored 8 of his 12 points in the first half as he sprinted from endline to endline, diving for loose balls and breaking the Ironman press with his nifty ball handling.



Terry Copeland grabbed recorded four blocked shots in the opening half and grabbed a rebound, putting it back up and into the basket.

Bergen got strong bench play from Dave Munro (4 points, 2 rebounds and a blocked shot), Declan Wucherpennig (6 points 1 steal, 1 rebound and 1 blocked shot) and Austin Spencer (11 points and 1 rebound).



The Crusaders continued to push in the second half, but an outstanding Ironman squad made a push led by Dylan Harper and his game-high 38 points. Copeland came back in the fourth quarter to hit a huge 3 pointer and McQuaid hit 4 free throws while Naiim Parrish hit three of the last four in the game to ice the victory for the Crusaders 76-70. Bergen

had fallen 3 times this season to the Ironmen by double-digits each time, but showed incredible character and determination to reach the sectional final once again.

**March 1 - Somerset, NJ** - The formula was working. Run. Press. Big men, Terry Copeland and Brandon Benjamin lead in the paint. Then the third quarter wiped away all progress made to the Crusaders' bid for a third consecutive sectional title. Despite a passionate effort in the fourth, the last of two shots fell outside the rim and the final buzzer sounded, giving St. Peter's Prep the victory 56-55.



Brandon Benjamin's 13 points, 4 rebounds, 3 blocks and 2 steals led the Crusaders. The 6'8 junior was all over the court, running from end-line to end-line making his presence felt from the opening tip until the final buzzer.

Sophomore Naiim Parrish scored in each period, including three free-throws when he was fouled shooting a three-pointer. He finished with 12 points and a rebound.





Terry Copeland and Austin Spencer each scored 8 points and sophomore guard Tyler McQuaid played very well, hustling all over the court and pitching in 6 points.

The Crusaders got strong bench play from sophomores Declan Wucherpfennig (4 pts, 1 reb, 1 block) and David Munro (2 pts, 2 reb, 2 blocks) and senior guard, Mikai Klintman 2 points and a steal.

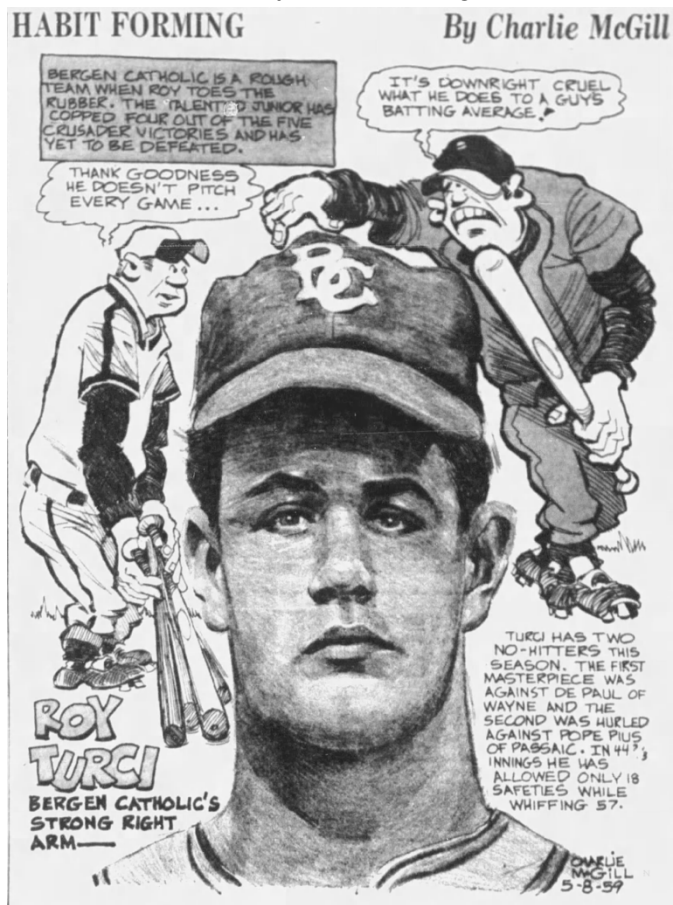

## BEFORE THERE WAS AN ATHLETE OF THE WEEK

**March 4 - Oradell, NJ** - As we close in toward baseball season, I came across this Charlie McGill sketch from 1959. Roy Turci threw two no-hitters during BC's inaugural 1959 varsity baseball season and his accomplishments in pitching were recorded in this way in *The Evening Record*.



Turci earned 1<sup>st</sup> Team All-TCCC Honors for his accomplished season (BC's first official varsity season) and was named Honorable Mention All-County. The Crusaders won the TCCC, their first baseball title.

In 1960, Turci opened the season throwing his third career no-hitter. The Crusaders finished with an 8-8 season and he earned 2<sup>nd</sup> Team All-TCCC and Honorable Mention All-County again.

Charlie McGill is still sketching the **Athlete of the Week** for what is now known as **Northjersey.com**. His last Bergen Catholic subject was our very own, Allan Hilton-Clarke, for Indoor Track this past winter season. Turci: 5/8/1959 - Clarke: 1/20/2023. How's that for an exceptional body of work?

## BIRD OF THE WEEK: THE MONK PARAKEET

**March 3 - Leonia, NJ** - I would like to thank Ms. Lopez for sharing this photo which will constitute our Bird of the Week: the Monk Parakeet.



Monk Parakeets are "urban dwellers" by nature. They create their own apartment systems of nests which are made up of sticks and twigs and house many birds.

They are a bird that comes up in the news occasionally because they have a propensity for building their nests on telephone poles with electrical transformers. They especially enjoy the heat from the transformers in the colder months.

Problem: **Heat + sticks and twigs = fire**. Sometimes. Those fires have been known to blow up the aforementioned transformers which can lead to blackouts in towns like Edgewater, where many of them have been found.

From what I have seen in recent years, there are fewer of these "apartment complexes" on telephone poles and more found in other structures and trees. Likely you can find Monk Parakeets in Leonia, Edgewater, Ridgefield Park and Hawthorne.

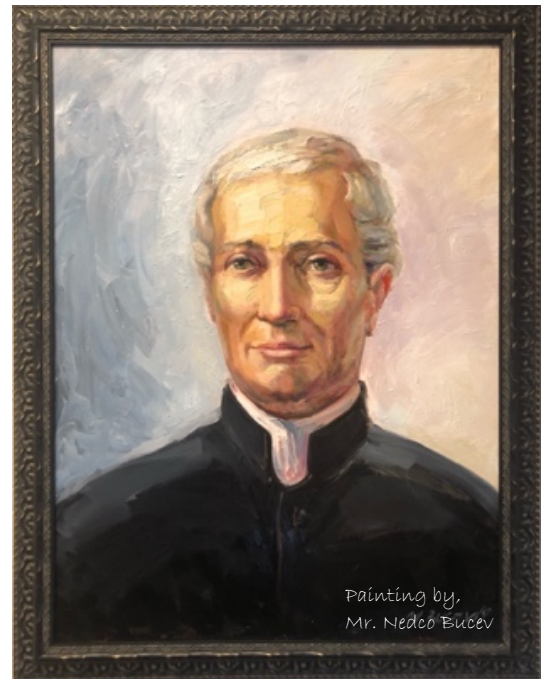
