THE BOYS ARE BACK!

Coaching: Bob Muggeo is entering his 9th year as head coach for the Bergen Catholic Baseball team. In his 8 seasons coaching Bergen Catholic baseball, he has a record 140 wins and 48 losses, a .745 winning percentage. It is the highest winning percentage before any coach with 7 or more seasons and second behind only Dionisio .838 winning percentage. His 140 victories is tied with founding coach Vic Liggio's 140 wins and he is fourth all-time behind Al Barton (230-15), John Picarello (151-69) and Joe Dionisio (145-28).

Team: The Bergen Catholic team lost 12 seniors from last year's roster; however, many starters return. Luca Reyes, who



will be attending the University of Miami next year, returns in center field. He is going to be crucial to the success for Bergen offensively. Offensive starters coming back are Seniors Harrison Certo (Bates College commit), Braden

Connors (Holy Cross commit), Aiden Baglino (Fairfield commit), and Sophomore Jamie Zee (Notre Dame commit).

The Crusader's ace, Christian Charalambous (Presbyterian commit), is returning after missing all of 2022. He will be a very important part in the team's pitching. Stanley Moreno is also returning who also missed a large part in last year's season. Also returning from the pitching staff are Seniors

Jack Duffy, Alex Cavegn, Dhurv Vengurlekar (NYU Commit), and Junior Luke Dellentash.

Schedule: The baseball team finished at 17-9 in last year's season. The Crusaders will face a rigorous schedule this upcoming season. Some of the biggest games to look out for are The Hun School, Poly Prep, Delbarton, and rival Don Bosco. The team has high expectations and are hoping to finish with upwards of 20 wins. The Crusaders have their eyes set on both County and State Championships for this season.

This is her first head coaching opportunity in the volleyball program and has done a great job recruiting athletes as last year they had a struggling season.

Coach DeBellis is working on the mindset of her student-athletes. She never wants them to go into a game expecting an easy victory. Our opponents are always looking to make their mark against Bergen Catholic. We need to go in ready to work and play hard like we've been doing in practices.

A major advantage for the Crusaders is that they have a smart, strong setter (Captain; Ian Walls, Senior), a few returning upperclassmen, and newcomers that are eager to perform for their teammates. Once the boys start playing together more they will pick up on each other's tendencies and be able to play with a more fluid approach.

The Crusaders are eager to see the development of our libero, Captain; Thomas Cusick, Senior. He is the positive mindset that this team needs and follows his instincts that allows him to get digs that otherwise would be kills for our opponents. Our outside hitter (Captain; Luca Duardo, Senior), is a relentless competitor and wants nothing more than to improve and compete, his mindset is the difference in who Bergen Catholic Volleyball was and where it's going. 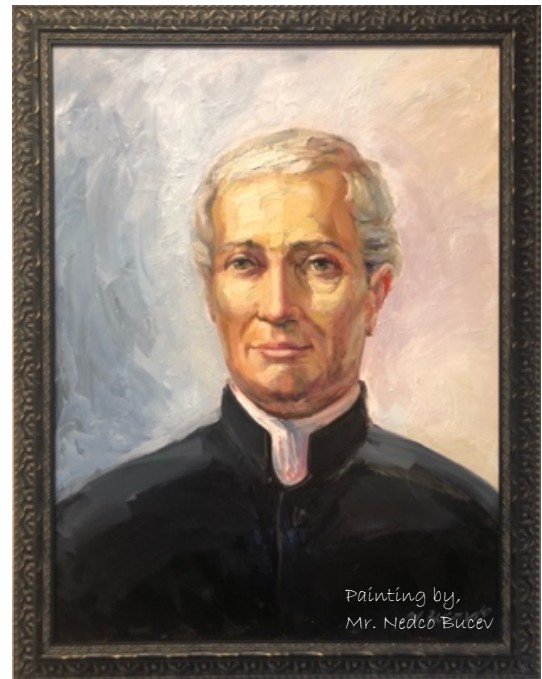
