CRUSADERS WIN FIFTH CONSECUTIVE BERGEN COUNTY RELAY TITLE SET FOUR SCHOOL RECORDS

April 20-22 - Oradell, NJ - The Crusaders won a fifth straight title, 136-108, over Paramus Catholic at River Dell Regional HS over the weekend.

According to Coach Mike Begen, "We're going for school records and county records and our ultimate goal is to get into the state conversation."

The Crusaders led all schools in three events, the 4-x-100 (where Logan Casey, Kaj Sanders, Allan Hilton Clarke and Andrew Boakye broke a school record with 41.78), shot and discus, setting school records in each. BC also have seven top

three finishes overall and broke a 4th school record in the 4-x-200.

Tom Rogers played a role in winning four individual relay teams and Ben Shue was named "Athlete of the Meet" following his performances in shotput and discus.

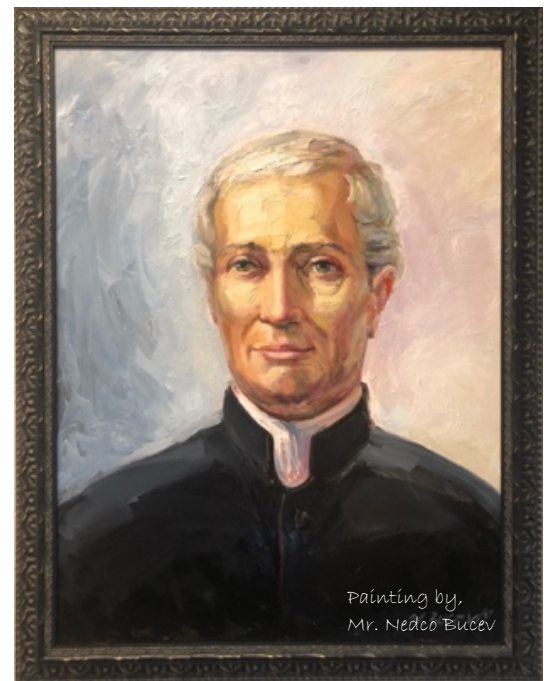
