


JV BASEBALL SLAYS GREEN KNIGHTS May 1 - Montvale, NJ - The Crusader JV Baseball Team





BIRD OF THE WEEK:

May 6 – Mahwah, NJ – I was talking to my mom and dad early on Saturday morning about our mutual looking forward to seeing our first Ruby-throated hummingbird of 2023. We figured it was just about time and despite well-prepared nectar-filled feeders, they had not yet seen one.

As I passed into the field just north of the muddy parking lot on Halifax Road and the Ramapo River, I was sharing this conversation with a fellow birder. Just then I looked and hovering in midair about 30 yards away was...



A hummingbird. This is not the picture of him. I say him, though with that particular bird, I could not see the tell-tale ruby throat which distinguishes the male from the female.

This is a peculiar picture. I took it of a male hummer (I saw its throat as it was perched on a dead tree than I annually see hummingbirds). You are seeing him fly away and his tail feathers expanded and his wings in mid beat. His bill is facing 4:00 and his feet pointed more toward 8:00.

He generally has a multiple pairs that visit his feeder in the Poconos. If you'd like to learn more about attracting these attractive birds, check out the article at the link below.

Soaring overhead, this appears to be a young red-tailed hawk. If you notice the whitish edges to the back of its wings, and the completeness of all of its wings, this bird does not present as and older, weathered bird would. Additionally, it has all of its feathers. Older birds chased by crows and others will often lose some feathers in the heat of the chase.
