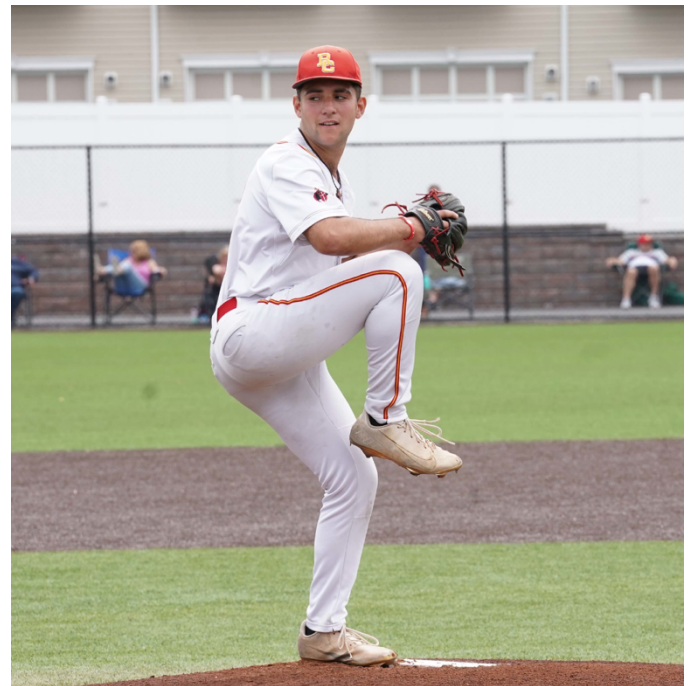

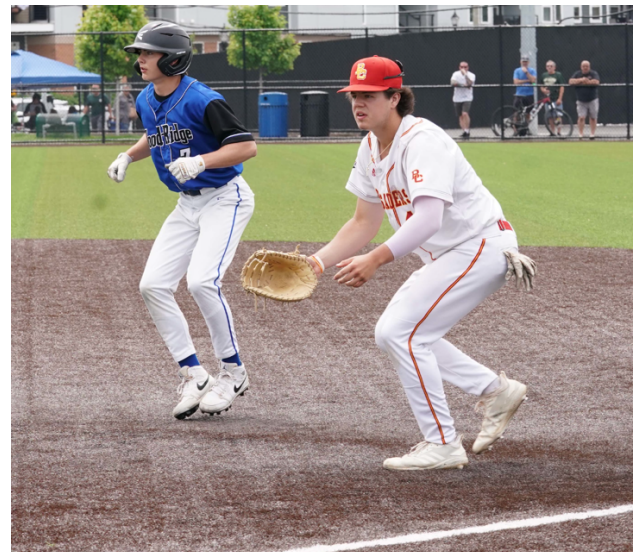

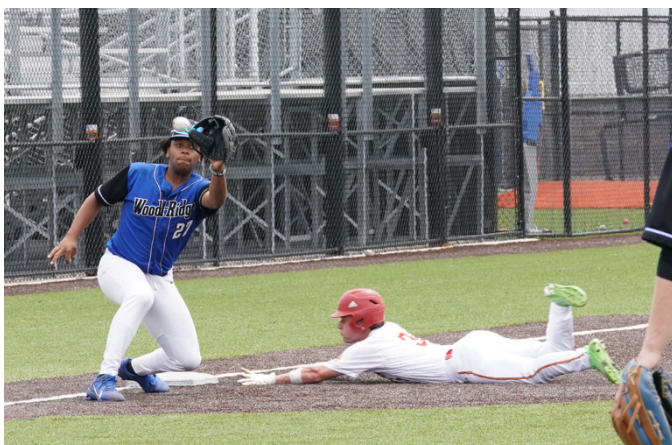

BIRD OF THE WEEK:

ROSE-BREASTED GROSBEAK

May 13 - Bergen County, NJ - After birding from 6:15am - about 5:00pm, I identified 79 species of birds. See the list (next column).



Sometimes it's interesting just to watch the behaviors of birds at a feeder. As my dad likes to point out, finches (House finch and American Goldfinch) sit at a feeder for longer periods of time, while others like chickadees and titmice stop onto the feeder, take a seed and leave and then return.

Cardinal pairs don't seem to mind feeding together at the feeder, but the rose-breasted grosbeaks I observed have typically been more chivalrous with the female eating, sitting at the feeder for 30 seconds to a minute, followed shortly

after by a male. Two males may eat together at times, but I have not observed a male and female eating simultaneously yet.

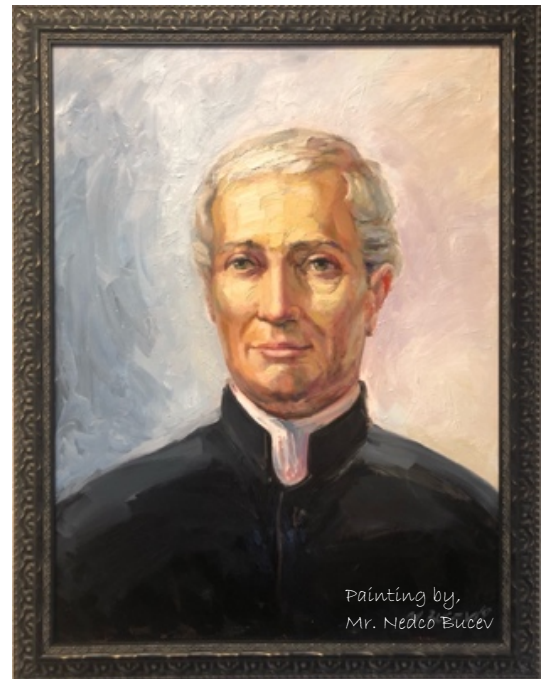

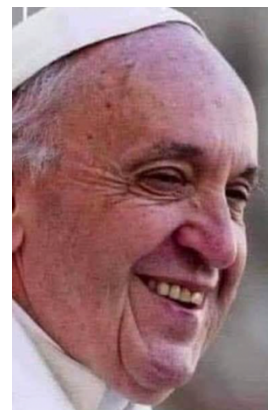
