The Crusaders will be playing their first game ever at Count Basie Field in Red Bank. The scarlet and gold hopes to extend their current opening day win-streak to 10 (second-longest opening day streak since 26 from 1978-2003).

William "Count" Basie was a legendary jazz pianist, bandleader and composer, born in 1904 and raised in Red Bank. He formed his Count

Basie Orchestra in 1935 and developed a unique swing jazz style.

Basie was inducted into the *New Jersey Hall of Fame* in 2010 and the *Blues Hall of Fame* in 2019. The next time you're in southern California, you can find his star in the walk of fame at 6508 Hollywood Blvd, Hollywood, CA.

So if you're in the mood, give yourself a treat and listen to some of Basie's classics like, *Jumpin'* at the Woodside, One O'Clock Jump and of course, *April in Paris*, on the ride home tonight.

Coach Campanile took the helm at Bergen Catholic in 2018, succeeding brother, Nunzio, who led BC to a state championship in 2017. Coach Vito immediately found success during the 2018 season, leading BC to the state final before the Crusaders were upset by St. Joseph Regional at MetLife Stadium.

Following a five-and-four 2019 campaign, Covid-19 prevented Campanile's #1-ranked Crusaders from pursuing a state championship as the state tournament was cancelled for the season.

In 2021, Coach Campanile led BC to its 18th state championship and second-ever 12-0 record. The Crusaders were the class of the state of New Jersey and earned the school's highest ever ranking to date of #3 in the country. Last year, the Crusaders defeated Don Bosco Prep in the State Final 45-0 to clinch the school's 19th State Championship.

In recognition of his commitment to excellence and leadership, Coach Campanile was recognized by the **USAToday** as the Nation's High School Boys Coach of the Year.

In five years at the helm of BC, Coach Campanile has a record of 43-8 (.843 winning percentage), one state championship and three-straight #1 rankings in NJ. In his 16-year head coaching career, Coach Campanile has a record of 126-58 (a .685 winning percentage).

THE CRUSADERS ON OFFENSE

Three four-star recruits expect to make an impact on the offensive side of the football in 2023. Georgia-bound left tackle, #79 Nyier Daniels anchors the left-side of the offensive line at the tackle position. Left guard #64 Owen Fernandez and center #50 Marcus Linder, also return from a group that amassed 4,332 yards and 410 points last season. Add three-sport star, #75 Benji Shue big RT #56 Chris Vigna and you have the potential for the top OL in the state.

Rutgers-commit running back, #1 Kaj Sanders (33 carries for 253 yards, 7.7 YPC - and 3 TDs) is the four-star man who excels on both sides of the ball. He brings to mind some of the finest in BC history, though his speed has potential to set new standards at the position. Expect junior running back, #30 Mu Russell to figure into the equation of this balanced attack in a considerable way as well.

Four-star junior wide receiver #0 Quincy Porter (35 catches, 662 yards and 11 TDs – 18.9 YPC) is just flat-out scary. He partners with classmate QB, #17 Dominic Campanile (1168 yards, 14 TDs, 3 INTs, 67.5 COMP % & 66 carries for 199 yards, 2TDs rushing). The two have incredible chemistry and are in the process of re-writing BC's record books.

BERGEN CATHOLIC ON DEFENSE

There is no doubt the Crusaders need to rebuild up front. Graduating perhaps the two most dominant defensive linemen in school history as well as a first-team all-state middle linebacker can do that to you.

Recent Bergen Catholic Hall of Fame inductee and Defensive Coordinator, Tony DeBellis, has plenty of pieces left to put together a formidable group for any opponent. Defensive linemen #93 Elijah Kinsler and #99 Delaney Flood will work to secure the front and juniors

#14 Kaden Irby-Mason and #47 David Matesic bring experience from a linebacking corps that graduated some talented, senior players.

In the secondary, Naiim Parrish returns at corner after setting a BC sophomore record for interceptions in a season as he led the 2022 Bergen squad with 5. He and safeties #1 Kaj Sanders and #14 Chris Mimmo and sophomore corners Jordan Thomas and freshman Anthony Willis create one of the most talented secondaries in the land.

THE CASEYS ON OFFENSE

The home team as a terrific big-play threat in senior wide-out #18 Emmanuel Ross. The 6'2, 185-pound Stanford commit and is coming off an outstanding season. In 2022, he hauled in 29 catches for 615 yards (21.2 yards per catch) and 10 TDs. In his career, he stands at 44 catches, 898 yards and 15 TDs.

Junior QB Frankie Williams is one of the top '25 QBs in the state and returns, following a strong sophomore campaign. He completed 60.6% of his passes for 1,625 yards, 20 TDs and just two interceptions.

Williams showed he can run as well, gaining 299 yards on 66 carries and 3 TDs.

The Caseys have a pair of scholarship offensive linemen in Lorenzo Portella and Tyler Burnham who provide time and space for some outstanding skill guys to do their work.

THE CASEYS ON DEFENSE

The Caseys' strength on defense starts at the linebacker position with Davin Brewton. The senior led RBC in tackles with 108 last season, including 15 tackles for a loss, one forced fumble and recovery and one interception. Luke Wassef adds to the experience at the LB position with his 60 tackles

The Caseys are not afraid to have their players compete on both sides of the ball. Expect to see Lorenzo Portella on defense (returns with 42 tackles and 4 TFLs) as well as Logan Graham 56 tackles, 12 TFLs).

Senior Punter/Kicker Justin LaMorte was off in the 2022 season opener, missing both field goals, but he went on to hit his last three field goals of the season, including a long of 44-yards against Curtis (NY). LaMorte also hit 29 of 30 PATs, with a 2/2 streak entering this season. If a back-up is needed, sophomore athlete, Blake Caruso was 17 or 18 in PATs in 2022.

The Caseys' two primary returners graduated in 2022, but Ross has some experience back there from his sophomore year, so don't be surprised to see #18 deep at times.

BC is 2-0 vs. Red Bank Catholic, but the two teams have not met in 13 years. Both games (2007 and 2010) were played at Crusader Stadium in the Quarterfinal round of the NJSIAA Non-Public 4 tournaments.

The Crusaders won a decisive 43-7 decision in 2007 as Danny Smith, James Williams, Joe Wagner (RIP), Tom Randall and Mike Halligan all scored for BC. Rob Eckrote threw a pair of TD passes for Bergen as they advanced.

In 2010, a feisty Casey group shut out the Crusaders in the third quarter and put up a pair of TDs to close a Bergen lead to 35-26. Future NFLers, Tanner McEvoy and Cameron Dickerson helped BC to 30 fourth-quarter points to seal the deal in a 65-34 Crusader win.
