2023 BERGEN CATHOLIC CRUSADERS AT A GLANCE



The Crusaders enter today's game under the direction of Head Coach, Vito Campanile, the eleventh coach in program history. Coach Campanile has done nothing but polish an apple, leading the Crusaders to three consecutive #1 state rankings and two straight Non-Public "A" State Championships with a top 25 rankings in the USA Today and MaxPreps in 2021 (#3) and 2022 (#20).

BC was recognized by MaxPreps as the top high school football team in the state of New Jersey as we enter the season.



VITO VENI VICI

Coach Campanile has done nothing but enhance the quality of the Crusader Football brand in his time at the helm. Here's a look at the Vito Campanile Years:

Coach Campanile took the helm at Bergen Catholic in 2018, succeeding brother, Nunzio, who led BC to a state championship in 2017. Coach Vito immediately found success during the 2018 season, leading BC to the state final before the Crusaders were upset by St. Joseph Regional at MetLife Stadium.

Following a five-and-four 2019 campaign, Covid-19 prevented Campanile's #1-ranked Crusaders from pursuing a state championship as the state tournament was cancelled for the season.

In 2021, Coach Campanile led BC to its 18th state championship and second-ever 12-0 record. The Crusaders were the class of the state of New Jersey and earned the school's highest ever ranking to date of #3 in the country.

Last year, the Crusaders defeated Don Bosco Prep in the State Final 45-0 to clinch the school's 19th State Championship.

In recognition of his commitment to excellence and leadership, Coach Campanile was recognized by the **USAToday** as the Nation's High School Boys Coach of the Year.

In five years at the helm of BC, Coach Campanile has a record of 43-8 (.843 winning percentage), one state championship and three-straight #1 rankings in NJ. In his 16-year head coaching career, Coach Campanile has a record of 126-58 (a .685 winning percentage).

BERGEN CATHOLIC ON OFFENSE

Four-star Rutgers-commit, #1 Kaj Sanders (9 carries for 72 yards and 2 TDs) led the Crusader ground game which picked up 136 yards against Red Bank Catholic. #23 Mu Russell added 42 yards on 10 carries and signal-caller #17 Dominic Campanile had a 12 yard scamper which wiped out the yardage attributed to one sack against him (in high school statistics, sacks are counted as rushing yards, always in the negative).

Campanile was efficient, completing 17 of 26 passes for 165 yards and to six different targets. He and WR/Slot, #2 Anthony Perrotti made magic on a 35-yard scoring strike before the half, to extend BC's lead to 17-0. Perrotti finished with six receptions for 56 yards. Four-star junior wide receiver #0 Quincy Porter hauled in four passes for 49 yards, bringing him past the 700 reception yards mark. He partners with classmate QB, #17 Dominic Campanile (1168 yards, 14 TDs, 3 INTs, 67.5 COMP % & 66 carries for 199 yards, 2TDs rushing). Junior TE John Morris caught a couple of passes for first downs and Michael Campanile, Naiim Parrish and Luca Cuttita all grabbed Dominic Campanile darts.

The offensive line helped protect the quarterback, yielding only one sack in 26 attempts and grounding out 294 yards of total offense. From left-to-right, expect to see LT #79 Nyier Daniels, LG #64 Owen Fernandez, C #50 Marcus Linder, RG #72 Ben Shue and RT #56 Chris Vigna.

BERGEN CATHOLIC ON DEFENSE

The Crusaders looked strong in their opener, holding a potent Red Bank Catholic squad to just 188 yards of total offense. While graduation raised some questions about the effectiveness of this squad, they answered the bell leading BC to a game one victory, yielding only a fourth quarter touchdown after the game was well in-hand.

Recent Bergen Catholic Hall of Fame inductee and Defensive Coordinator, Tony DeBellis, has plenty of pieces left to put together a formidable group for any opponent. #7 Ethan Cohal registered a pair of sacks and defensive tackle #8 Elijah Kinsler and linebacker #14 Kaden Irby-Mason each recorded a sack in the effort.

In the secondary, #5 Naiim Parrish returns at corner after setting a BC sophomore record for interceptions in a season as he led the 2022 Bergen squad with 5. He and senior #1 Kaj Sanders and freshman #24 Anthony Willis will hold down the fort at safety after losing senior, Chris Mimmo in the season opener. Sophomore corner #23 Jordan Thomas helps to create one of the most talented secondaries in the land.

BERGEN CATHOLIC SPECIAL TEAMS

Senior punter #25 Brandon Arpacilar got off three excellent punts (41.7 average) good for a net average of 35 yards. Junior place kicker #37 Guytano Bartolomeo, BC's points man, picked up where he left off last season. He led BC's scoring effort with the season's first points, a 28-

yard first-quarter field goal. After that, G was 3-for-3 on PATs. He also picked up kick-off duties, driving 2 of five kicks into the endzone for touchbacks.

Junior Anthony Perrone (KOR) returned one kick for 11 yards, but on a punt-return side, BC will have to find some answers with the loss of sure-handed Mimmo.

IONA PREP GAELS AT A GLANCE



The Gaels enter today's game under the direction of Head Coach, Joe Spagnolo. Coach Spagnolo is now in his 12th season at the helm of the Gaels. He boasts an exceptional 114-27 record entering the 2022 campaign. That's good for an .809 winning percentage.

Spagnolo, a 1998 Iona Prep graduate and former varsity quarterback took the reins of the program after a long tenure as assistant at Archbishop Stepinac.

The Gaels have it going on as they enter their season opener at The Jack, winning 25 of their last 29 dating back to the Covid-19 shortened Spring season of 2021.

In an absolutely perfect south-east Pennsylvania evening in Warminster as the Crusaders visited Archbishop Wood and opened the season strong. A first quarter double-reverse flea-flicker was run to perfection as Dylan Classi scored his first of two TDs in the game on a pass from future Rutgers star, Johnny Langan.

The Crusader defense was strong, especially in the first half, holding the Vikings to just three 30+ yard field goals after the hosts ran 47 plays to BC's 15.

Twenty Crusaders made their first varsity starts on that Friday night but the story was junior QB, Johnny Langan, who was stellar throwing for over 160 yards and four touchdowns, and running for 133 yards on just 13 carries.
