CRUSADERS SEEK A CHALLENGE IN SOUTH FLORIDA WITH C-M

This evening the Bergen Catholic Football team invades southeast Florida in an age-old match-up between the Lions and the Crusaders. Chaminade-Madonna is currently ranked #7 in the USA by MaxPreps, entering with a 2-0 record. The Crusaders are currently #19 and stand at 2-0 as well.

2023 BERGEN CATHOLIC CRUSADERS AT A GLANCE



The Crusaders enter today's game under the direction of Head Coach, Vito Campanile, the eleventh coach in program history. Coach Campanile has done nothing but polish an apple, leading the Crusaders to three consecutive #1 state rankings and two straight Non-Public "A" State Championship with a top 25 rankings in the USA Today and MaxPreps in 2021 (#3) and 2022 (#20).

BC was recognized by MaxPreps as the top high school football team in the state of New Jersey as we enter the season.

Coach Campanile took the helm at Bergen Catholic in 2018, succeeding brother, Nunzio, who led BC to a state championship in 2017. Coach Vito immediately found success during the 2018 season, leading

BC to the state final before the Crusaders were upset by St. Joseph Regional at MetLife Stadium.

Following a five-and-four 2019 campaign, Covid-19 prevented Campanile's #1-ranked Crusaders from pursuing a state championship as the state tournament was cancelled for the season.

In 2021, Coach Campanile led BC to its 18th state championship and second-ever 12-0 record. The Crusaders were the class of the state of New Jersey and earned the school's highest ever ranking to date of #3 in the country. Last year, the Crusaders defeated Don Bosco Prep in the State Final 45-0 to clinch the school's 19th State Championship.

In recognition of his commitment to excellence and leadership, Coach Campanile was recognized by the **USAToday** as the Nation's High School Boys Coach of the Year.

In five complete seasons at the helm of BC, Coach Campanile has a record of 43-8 (.843 winning percentage), two state championship and three-straight #1 rankings in NJ. His 16-year head coaching career, Coach Campanile has a record of 126-58 (a .685 winning percentage) entering 2023.

FOUR TD CATCH GAME HELPS CRUSADERS WIN BIG OVER IONA PREP

Campanile to Porter produces 24 points.

September 2 - Oradell, NJ - The Iona Prep defense was solid for three out of four drives in the first quarter. BC was only able to generate a Guytano Bartolomeo field goal and 3-0 lead at the end of one.

Enter the Campanile- Porter Combination.

Dominic Campanile hit Quincy Porter for a 78-yard electrifying strike and it was clear things were about to change in the second quarter. After stopping the Gaels on defense, the Crusaders struck with a 28-yard score!

Running back Kaj Sanders popped in from the two yard line as Bartolomeo continued to remain perfect with his kicking opportunities and BC was up 24-0, but not finished.

The Crusader defense was stifling holding their guests to just 135 total yards in offense and intercepting three Gael passes (one by Naiim Noble, one by Brandon Gomez, who returned it 31 yards, and one by sophomore linebacker Tim Hogan).

A 58-yard strike made it 31-0 at the half and then a 6-yard TD completion between the two finished off BC's scoring in the third quarter and set the game into running time.

RECORD BREAKERS

TOUCHDOWN RECEPTIONS IN ONE GAME (ANY POSITION/ANY YEAR)? Hail to Quincy Porter – 4.

RECEIVING YARDS IN ONE GAME BY A WR? Unofficially, Quincy's 183 receiving yards may very well have set the mark. More on that in the near future.

TD PASSES BY A JUNIOR QB? Matt Lovecchio threw for five TD passes as a junior vs. Bloomfield (62-14 victory) in 1998. Dominic's four-TD effort tied the previous record-holder, Joe Piela's record of 4 he set in 1993 vs. Paterson Kennedy.

YARDS PER CATCH? Despite Quincy's staggering 30.5 yards per catch, the single game record (at least 2 catches) is a way off. Dave Ficca had a pair for 58.0 YPC vs. Essex Catholic in 1979. The junior Crusaders record is a healthy 53.0 YPC by Jimmy Delahaunty vs. Fordham Prep in 1961.

WHAT ABOUT CUSH? Crusader faithful might remember Brian Cushing's 5-TD effort vs. St. Joseph Regional in a 2004, 56-42 victory over the Green Knights, which is a school record for TDs (5) and points (30) by a BC player in a football game. Brian scored his touchdowns in different ways: 3 receiving (including an awesome play on a fake punt), 1 rushing and 1 kickoff return. A number of players have recorded 3-TD receiving games, but Quincy's 4 set a new mark to chase.

INTERCEPTION CHASE: Sophomore Interception Record Holder, Naiim Parrish (now a junior) added to his collection, nabbing his first of the season and 6th of his career vs. Iona Prep.

STREAKING: The Crusaders are quietly building a winning streak since their early 2022 loss to Don Bosco Prep. Current streak stands at NINE (9).

CHAMINADE-MADONNA LIONS AT A GLANCE



The Lions are currently ranked #7 in the nation by MaxPreps and it is a well-earned ranking. Head Coach Dameon Jones is in his 7th year at the helm and boasts a 70-10 overall record and his Lions are two-time defending Florida state champions. His Lions were 13-1 last season and won their opening games of 2023 to bring us to this point.

THE LIONS ON OFFENSE

Unquestionably, there is talent and experience on the field. The #1 WR recruit in the nation (and #2 overall player) #4 Jeremiah Smith is the Lions' top WR. The 2024 commit to Ohio State has over 1700 receiving yards in his three years as a starter. He scored 20 of his career 28 TDs last season and has two in two games in 2023. Transfer receiver #1 Joshisa Trader is ranked 44th nationally overall and 3rd at his position (ATHLETE). He had a catch last week for the Lions. It will be interesting to see the impact he makes. #7 – Sr – Davion Gause - RB - has been carrying much of the load in the early season. The UNC-

bound ball carrier opened the season on ESPN+ with 176 yards on 17 carries. He was a First-Team All-American in his junior year.

Those players are directed by three year-starter and NC State-commit Cedrick Bailey. The 6'6-190 lb quarterback has passed for 5,991 yards in his career entering tonight's game. He threw 45 touchdown passes last year and has 72 overall in his career. He can move as well, rushing for over 400 yards and a 10.4 yards per carry average throughout.

The skill is talented, and there is talent on the line as well, but a number of players are newly transferred athletes.

THE LIONS ON DEFENSE

#0 Zaquan Patterson - CB - had a pick six early in the season. He has committed to Miami and enters with tonight's contest with 6 career interceptions, 147 tackles (77 solo) and 5 sacks. Strong-Safety #6 Denzel Johnson, is CM's leading tackler. He has 228 career tackles including 103 solos and 16 sacks. Johnson is one of those guys who has a nose for the ball and runs sideline-to-sideline making plays.
