PORTER'S RECORD-SETTING FOUR TD CATCH GAME HELPS CRUSADERS WIN BIG OVER IP

Campanile to Porter produces 24 points.

September 2 - Oradell, NJ - The Iona Prep defense was solid for three out of four drives in the first quarter. BC was only able to generate a Guytano Bartolomeo field goal and 3-0 lead at the end of one.



Enter the Campanile-Porter Combination.



Dominic Campanile hit Quincy Porter for a 78-yard electrifying strike and it was clear things were about to change in the second quarter. After stopping the Gaels on defense, the Crusaders struck with a 28-yard score!

Running back Kaj Sanders popped in from the two yard line as Bartolomeo continued to remain perfect with his kicking opportunities and BC was up 24-0, but not finished.

The Crusader defense was stifling holding their guests to just 135 total yards in offense and intercepting three Gael passes (one by Naiim Noble, one by Brandon Gomez, who returned it 31 yards, and one by sophomore linebacker Tim Hogan).

A 58-yard strike made it 31-0 at the half and then a 6-yard TD completion between the two finished off BC's scoring in the third quarter and set the game into running time.

RECORD BREAKERS

TOUCHDOWN RECEPTIONS IN ONE GAME (ANY POSITION/ANY YEAR)? Hail to Quincy Porter – 4.



GAME BY A WR? Unofficially, Quincy's 183 receiving yards may very well have set the mark. More on that in the near future.

TD PASSES BY A JUNIOR QB? Matt Lovecchio threw for five TD

passes as a junior vs. Bloomfield (62-14 victory) in 1998. Dominic's four-TD effort tied the previous record-holder, Joe Piela's record of 4 he set in 1993 vs. Paterson Kennedy.

YARDS PER CATCH? Despite Quincy's staggering 30.5 yards per catch, the single game record (at least 2 catches) is a way off. Dave Ficca had a pair for 58.0 YPC vs. Essex Catholic in 1979. The junior Crusaders record is a healthy 53.0 YPC by Jimmy Delahaunty vs. Fordham Prep in 1961.

WHAT ABOUT CUSH? Crusader faithful might remember Brian Cushing's 5-TD effort vs. St. Joseph Regional in a 2004, 56-42 victory over the Green Knights, which is a school record for TDs (5) and points (30) by a BC player in a football game. Brian scored his touchdowns in different ways: 3 receiving

(including an awesome play on a fake punt), 1 rushing and 1 kickoff return. A number of players have recorded 3-TD receiving games, but Quincy's 4 set a new mark to chase.

INTERCEPTION CHASE: Sophomore Interception Record Holder, Naiim Parrish (now a junior) added to his collection, nabbing his first of the season and 6th of his career vs. Iona Prep.

STREAKING: The Crusaders are quietly building a winning streak since their early 2022 loss to Don Bosco Prep. Current streak stands at NINE (9).

FROSH LOOK STRONG VS IONA PREP

September 3 - New Rochelle, NY - The Freshman Football team was too much for the Frosh Gaels to handle as they battled it out on Wellington T. Mara Field at Iona Prep.



The Crusaders got on the scoreboard with a first quarter 41-yard punt return for a touchdown by Austin Busso.

QB Aiden Talley hit Brian Porter for a two-point conversion and the Crusaders had an 8-0 lead.

Tristan Herring had a

tremendous day and recorded back-to-back tackles for a loss on the Gaels' next possession. Herring would later go onto rush for a touchdown and he made a beautiful catch for another (unfortunately called back due to a penalty).

RB/LB Faheem Lipscomb-Ausbon ran for a 6 yard touchdown and after Talley connected with Busso for the PAT, Bergen led 16-0.

Bryan Porter was nearly unstoppable at wide receiver, showing a strong ability to catch passes in traffic, the most noteworthy, a 3rd and 25 post route he



hauled in for a 40 yard gain and a first down.

After the called back Talley-to-Herring TD was called back, Aiden was intercepted by a 6-6, 240 pound defensive end

who started to return the pick. Talley made an excellent solo tackle to prevent a score and helped to set up BC's defense for success.

On the next play, LB/SS/RB Nick Mauro intercepted. Then Talley hit Mauro for a 53-yard touchdown pass. The PAT was incomplete and BC led 22-0.



The Gaels were driving and decided to go for a first down on a fourth and inches. Sadly for them, they did not count on Alexander Kavallieratos, who sacked the QB and ended the threat.



Mauro carried the ball 37 yards to the red-zone and on the next play, QB Jack Woods handed to Herring who scored from two yards out. Ausbon sprinted in for the 2-point conversion and at 30-0, the scoreboard went out and BC continued to dominate.

JV FOOTBALL OPENS STRONG

September 4 - Oradell, NJ - The Junior Varsity picked up where the varsity left off, Monday morning at The Jack. Devon Zitt completed a 3rd and 3 pass to Devin Hasan for a 15 yard touchdown to open the scoring and give Bergen a first guarter 6-0 lead. The PAT was unsuccessful.

As time wound down in the third quarter, Max Nizza went to work. On four carries, the hard-nosed sophomore running back took twenty yards to the Iona Prep 47. The no-huddle and Nizza ran 17, 4 and 12 yards on successive carries which forced the Gaels called time-out to stop the tempo. Enter Eddie Stoker who bullied his way 14 yards from the 19 to the

five. On the next play, he found his way to paydirt. The quarter ended and BC held a 12-0 lead. It was an awesome drive behind the likes of TEs Matt Daly and Jackson Kolomer, LT Mike McMahon, LG Harold Kang, C Travis Nodelman, RG Jaiden Santiago and RT Hudson Brennan.
