#### **2023 BERGEN CATHOLIC CRUSADERS AT A GLANCE**



The Crusaders enter today's game under the direction of Head Coach, Vito Campanile, the eleventh coach in program history. Coach Campanile has done nothing but polish an apple, leading the Crusaders to three consecutive #1 state rankings and two straight Non-Public

"A" State Championship with a top 25 rankings in the USA Today and MaxPreps in 2021 (#3)and 2022 (#20).

BC was recognized by MaxPreps as the top high school football team in the state of New Jersey as we enter the season.

Coach Campanile took the helm at Bergen Catholic in 2018, succeeding brother, Nunzio, who led BC to a state championship in 2017. Coach Vito immediately found success during the 2018 season, leading BC to the state final before the Crusaders were upset by St. Joseph Regional at MetLife Stadium.

Following a five-and-four 2019 campaign, Covid-19 prevented Campanile's #1-ranked Crusaders from pursuing a state championship as the state tournament was cancelled for the season.

In 2021, Coach Campanile led BC to its 18th state championship and second-ever 12-0 record. The Crusaders were the class of the state of New Jersey and earned the school's highest ever ranking to date of #3 in the

country. Last year, the Crusaders defeated Don Bosco Prep in the State Final 45-0 to clinch the school's 19<sup>th</sup> State Championship.

In recognition of his commitment to excellence and leadership, Coach Campanile was recognized by the **USA Today** as the Nation's High School Boys Coach of the Year.

In his first five years at the helm of BC, Coach Campanile has a record of 43-8 (.843 winning percentage), two state championships and threestraight #1 rankings in NJ and two league titles. In his 16-year head coaching career, Coach Campanile has a record of 126-58 (a .685 winning percentage).

#### **BERGEN CATHOLIC 2023 SCHEDULE AND RESULTS**

#### **BERGEN CATHOLIC ON OFFENSE**

The Crusader Offense starts with its explosive passing offense. Junior **QB Dominic Campanile (#17)** is an athletic southpaw slinger who has completed 58.8 percent of his passes for 1,490 yards. In just over two years, Campanile has completed 186 passes for 2,677 yards. He has 20 touchdown passes this year, raising his career total to 34.

Campanile's top target would be anyone's top target in NJ and beyond. **Quincy Porter (#0)** is a junior wide receiver who is already shattering all of BC's career records. He took down Aaron Martin's career TD reception record vs. Seton Hall Prep and currently stands at 26 for his career and 15 in 2023. Porter has 72 career receptions for 1,347 yards. This season his 37 catches for 796 yards (21.5 yards per catch). **Luca Cutitta (#6)** is developing into a big-play threat, especially after his exceptional performance against Don Bosco Prep at the end of September. The senior receiver has 9 receptions for 180 yards (20.0 ypc) and three touchdowns. Junior slot **Anthony Perrotti (#2)** is the team's second leading receiver with 25 catches and 227 yards and two touchdowns. Junior slotback **Michael Campanile (#4)** and sophomore running back **Dante Kain (#20)** also have touchdown receptions this season.

Four-star Rutgers-commit, **Kaj Sanders (#1)** currently leads the Crusader ground game with 693 yards on 83 carries (8.3 YPC). Sanders has twelve touchdowns on the season and is currently the team's second leading scorer. The Crusaders also have a duo of solid younger runners. Junior **Mu Russell (#23)** has 57 carries for 288 yards and three rushing touchdowns. TDs .

The offensive line has been dealing with some injuries and in the past two weeks, has relied on several younger players to pitch in to support the cause. That said, the team is averaging 33 points per game and has gained over 3000 yards. From left-to-right, expect to see LT Nyier Daniels (#79) and Rocco Costello (#71), LG Owen Fernandez (#64), C Marcus Linder (#50), RG Ben Shue (#72) and RT Chris Vigna (#56). Do not be surprised to see sophomore Mikey McMahon (#77) contribute as well.

#### **BERGEN CATHOLIC ON DEFENSE**

The Crusader defense has been sound, yielding only 16.1 points per game this season. They

Senior linebacker **Christian Gonzalez (#10)** leads all Crusader tacklers with 57 on the season. Junior linebacker **Kaden Irby-Mason (#14)** is a force on the outside with 40.

On the defensive line, senior West Virginia commit, **Elijah Kinsler** (#8) leads the group with 45 tackles, 3.5 sacks and 5 tackles for a loss. Junior DT **Delaney Flood (#99)** has two sack equivalents, a TFL and AN INTERCEPTION! At DE, junior **Ben Carey (#97)** with 36 tackles and 3 sacks and sophomore **Jermaine Kinsler (#88)** eight tackles and three sacks, help to set an edge.

In the secondary, junior corner **Naiim Parrish (#5)** has three interceptions on the year, after setting a BC sophomore record for interceptions in a season as he led the 2022 Bergen squad with 5. Parrish has 20 solo tackles. His superior play has encouraged opposing coordinators to attack the sophomore corner, **Jordan Thomas (#23)**. All Thomas has done is intercept four passes this season and leads the team in solo tackles with 20. Senior safety **Kaj Sanders (#1)** has 32 tackles on the season and provides senior leadership in an outstanding but dinged-up secondary. Freshman **Anthony Willis (#24)** is on the mend, but senior **Chris Mimmo (#3)** who is out for the season, have left an opportunity at the safety position for **Ethan Cohalt (#7)** and **Russell** (**#23)** to make their marks.

#### **BERGEN CATHOLIC SPECIAL TEAMS**

Senior punter **Brandon Arpacilar (#25)** is showing what an asset he is. The junior averages 37.9 yards per punt, a 34.8-yard net. He has a long of 57 yards and can help BC win the field position game in a tight game, pinning the opponent inside the 20 (so far 6 times this season). With an injury to Guy Bartolomeo, he did a fine job executing place-kicking duties, making all six of his XPAs.

Junior place kicker **Guytano Bartolomeo (#37)**, BC's points man, picked up where he left off last season. He is currently 30 for 30 on XPAs and 5 for 5 on FGAs in 2023. His career scoring total are: 102 points on 7/8 Field Goals and 81/82 PATs.

Juniors **Perrotti (#2)** and **Parrish (#5)** each average around 35 yards per kickoff return with Perrotti getting most of the attempts.

## PLAYOFFS? PLAYOFFS!

This season, the Crusaders are in pursuit of their 20<sup>th</sup> State Championship. Since the inception of the playoff system in 1974, BC has made 44 appearances in the tournament and have reached the final 31 times. Of those title game appearances, Bergen has won 16 titles and have an overall record of 64-28 (.695) in tournament play.

### QUARTERFINAL CHRONICLES

The Crusaders carry an 18-4 record (.818 win pct) into today's Quarterfinal Round game with Paul VI. The only other time these two schools met in football was at BC in 2014 in this round and the Crusaders won 49-20.

BC's first experience with quarterfinal round football was a peculiar instance in 1989. During a time period when only four teams per section qualified for the state tournament. The only exception to that rule would be if an undefeated team had fewer power points than the teams who qualified ahead of them. Hence, Bergen hosted Queen of Peace on a very soggy, muddy, quagmire of a field. The difference in the game? Three made extra-points by the Crusaders.

BC next played in a quarterfinal game vs. Bishop Ahr (now St. Thomas Aquinas). BC's Team of the Century, faced the Trojans who boasted the state's top scorer. He did not fare well on that day.

Brian Cushing made his playoff debut in the 2002 Camden Catholic game. Two of the biggest hits of the day echoed throughout Cherry Hill that night from the sophomore who would go on to become BC's top all-time football player.

#### **EAGLE OFFENSE AT A GLANCE**

**Dom Santiago (#5)** is the man who helps the Eagles soar. The senior 6'2-190 lb. signal caller has thrown for 1,700 yards (189 per game) with 26 touchdowns and six passes intercepted. He has completed 108 of 194 passes, a 55.7 completion percentage. He has thrown all but one pass this season for the Eagles. With over 3300 yards and 37 TD passes, I'm sure he'd love to hit the 3500/40 mark and direct his Eagles to victory today.

Senior running back **Matt Morad (#1)**has run for 1100 yards and 12 TDs this season. He is closing in on the 1500-yard mark for his career. **Santiago (#5)** joins him as a running threat, brining 292 yards and 3 TDs with him.

Tyree Roane (#4) headlines a deep receiver corps. The sophomore leads the Eagles with 39 catches, 585 yards and nine TDs. Morad (#1) has 22 catches for nearly 400 yards and five scores, while juniors Austin Bailey (#3), Jemelle Brown (#2) and Elijah Wilson (#52) combine for 700 yards and nine TDs.

#### **PAUL VI DEFENSE**

The heart of the Eagle's defense is linebacker **Mounir Keshen** (**#52**). The junior leads the team with 55 tackles and 9 tackles for a loss. Top ball hawks, **Brown (#2)** and **Bailey (#3)** each have a pair of interceptions on the season, accounting for half of the Eagles' picks this season.

#### **EAGLE SPECIAL TEAMS**

**Bailey (#3)** is a dangerous return man who has recorded a kickoff return for a touchdown this season. Sophomore **Blake Sholder (#32)** is doing a fine job as the team's place kicker.

#### **EAGLE ROSTER NOTE**

Freshman **Nathan Klecko** is following in his father (Dan) and grandfather's (Joe) footsteps as a defensive lineman for the Eagles. You may remember dad, Dan, as a member of the Patriots, Colts, Falcons and Philadelphia Eagles. Like his dad, he also finds some carries and blocking opportunities at fullback. Certainly his NFL Hall of Fame grandfather, Joe Klecko **73**, who played for the New York Jets and its **NEW YORK SACK EXCHANGE** back in the 70s and 80s brings back memories of NY area professional football to the more *seasoned*-fans among us.

#### **PVI PLAYOFF HISTORY**

The Eagles have made 13 playoff appearances. They have a record of 2-12 (.167), winning one sectional title. Their second playoff win came last weekend vs. previously undefeated Notre Dame 51-41.


