2023 BERGEN CATHOLIC CRUSADERS AT A GLANCE



The Crusaders enter today's game under the direction of Head Coach, Vito Campanile, the eleventh coach in program history. Coach Campanile has done nothing but polish an apple, leading the Crusaders to three consecutive #1 state rankings and two straight Non-Public "A" State Championship with a top 25 rankings in the USA Today and MaxPreps in 2021 (#3) and 2022 (#20).

BC was recognized by MaxPreps as the top high school football team in the state of New Jersey as we enter the season.



VITO VENI VICI

Coach Campanile has done nothing but enhance the quality of the Crusader Football brand in his time at the helm. Here's a look at the Vito Campanile Years:

Coach Campanile took the helm at Bergen Catholic in 2018, succeeding brother, Nunzio, who led BC to a state championship in 2017. Coach Vito immediately found success during the 2018 season, leading BC to the state final before the Crusaders were upset by St. Joseph Regional at MetLife Stadium.

Following a five-and-four 2019 campaign, Covid-19 prevented Campanile's #1-ranked Crusaders from pursuing a state championship as the state tournament was cancelled for the season.

In 2021, Coach Campanile led BC to its 18th state championship and second-ever 12-0 record. The Crusaders were the class of the state of New Jersey and earned the school's highest ever ranking to date of #3 in the

country. Last year, the Crusaders defeated Don Bosco Prep in the State Final 45-0 to clinch the school's 19th State Championship.

In recognition of his commitment to excellence and leadership, Coach Campanile was recognized by the **USA Today** as the Nation's High School Boys Coach of the Year.

In his first five years at the helm of BC, Coach Campanile has a record of 43-8 (.843 winning percentage), two state championships and three-straight #1 rankings in NJ and two league titles. In his 16-year head coaching career, Coach Campanile has a record of 126-58 (a .685 winning percentage).

BERGEN CATHOLIC ON OFFENSE

The Crusader Offense starts with its explosive passing offense. Junior **QB Dominic Campanile (#17)** is an athletic southpaw slinger who has completed 58.8 percent of his passes for 1,753 yards. In just over two years, Campanile has completed 186 passes for 2,940 yards. He has 25 touchdown passes this year, raising his career total to 39.

Campanile's top target would be anyone's top target in NJ and beyond. **Quincy Porter (#0)** is a junior wide receiver who is already shattering all of BC's career records. He took down Aaron Martin's career TD reception record vs. Seton Hall Prep and currently stands at 29 for his career and 18 in 2023. Porter has 78 career receptions for 1,489 yards. This season his 43 catches for 939 yards (21.8 yards per catch). **Luca Cutitta (#6)** is a big-play threat. The senior receiver has 10 receptions for 220 yards (22.0 ypc) and three touchdowns. Junior slot **Anthony Perrotti (#2)** is the team's second leading receiver with 30 catches and 286 yards and three touchdowns. Junior slotbacks **Michael Campanile (#4)**, **Matt Daly (#48)** and sophomore running back **Dante Kain (#20)** also have touchdown receptions this season.

Four-star Rutgers-commit, **Kaj Sanders (#1)** currently leads the Crusader ground game with 749 yards on 90 carries (8.3 YPC). Sanders has twelve touchdowns on the season and is currently the team's second leading scorer. The Crusaders also have a duo of solid younger runners. Junior **Mu Russell (#23)** has 56 carries for 288 yards and three rushing touchdowns. TDs.

The offensive line has been dealing with some injuries and in the past two weeks, has relied on several younger players to pitch in to support the cause. That said, the team is averaging 33 points per game and has gained over 1500 yards on the ground and 1800 yards through the air. Through ten games, the quintet has allowed only 7 sacks all season and only 42 negative plays total in 495 plays. In comparison, Crusader defenders have sacked opposing quarterbacks twenty-three times to date. From left-to-right, expect to see **LT Nyier Daniels (#79)** and **Rocco Costello (#71)**, **LG Owen Fernandez (#64)**, **C Marcus Linder (#50)**, **RG Ben Shue (#72)** and **RT Chris Vigna (#56)**. Do not be surprised to see sophomore **Mikey McMahon (#77)** contribute as well.

BERGEN CATHOLIC ON DEFENSE

The Crusader defense has been sound, yielding only 14.5 points per game this season and just under 270 yards per game.

Senior linebacker **Christian Gonzalez (#10)** leads all Crusader tacklers with 61 on the season. Sophomore, **Mason Marck (#44)** is a very solid Mike linebacker and Junior **Kaden Irby-Mason (#14)**. The Crusaders eagerly await the return of **Dave Matesic (#9)** to the line-up, but like typical Crusader defenses, this one is stacked with talent!

On the defensive line, senior West Virginia commit, **Elijah Kinsler (#8)** leads the group with 48 tackles, 3.5 sacks and 7 tackles for a loss. Junior DT **Delaney Flood (#99)** has two sack equivalents, a TFL and an interception. At DE, junior **Ben Carey (#97)** has 39 tackles, and 3 sacks and sophomore **Jermaine Kinsler (#88)** has made nine tackles, five and a half for a loss and three sacks.

In the secondary, junior corner **Naiim Parrish (#5)** has four interceptions on the year, after setting a BC sophomore record for interceptions in a season as he led the 2022 Bergen squad with 5. Parrish has 25 solo tackles. His superior play has encouraged opposing coordinators to attack the sophomore corner, **Jordan Thomas (#23)**. All Thomas has done is intercept four passes this season and leads the team in solo tackles with 30. Senior safety **Kaj Sanders (#1)** has 32 tackles on the season and provides senior leadership in an outstanding but dinged-up secondary. Freshman **Anthony Willis (#24)** is on the mend, but senior **Chris Mimmo (#3)** who is out for the season, have left an opportunity at the safety position for **Ethan Cohall (#7)**, **Russell (#23)** and **Brandon Gomez (#12)** to make their marks.

BERGEN CATHOLIC SPECIAL TEAMS

Senior punter **Brandon Arpacilar (#25)** is showing what an asset he is. The junior averages 37.4 yards per punt, a 34.1-yard net. He has a long of 57 yards and can help BC win the field position game in a tight game, pinning the opponent inside the 20 (so far 9 times this season). Arpacilar has proven he can also serve as an effective place kicker, nailing all six of his XPAs this year.

Junior place kicker **Guytano Bartolomeo (#37)**, BC's points man, picked up where he left off last season. He is currently 35 for 35 on XPAs and 5 for 5 on FGAs in 2023. His career scoring total are: 107 points on 7/8 Field Goals and 86/87 PATs.

Juniors **Perrotti (#2)** (27 yards per KOR) and **Parrish (#5)** (25 yards per KOR) make the most of their attempts and are always a threat to return one the distance.

CRUSADER FOOTBALL QUERY

WHEN DID BC START REGULARLY PLAYING ON SATURDAYS (AS OPPOSED TO SUNDAYS)?

The Crusaders regularly scheduled games on Sundays from their first season in 1958 through 1981. Though Saturday games were scheduled numerous times per year (typically 1-2), BC often had 4 or more Sunday games. In all, the Crusaders played 101 times on Sundays, with a record of 56-40-5 (.579 winning percentage). BC's last Sunday-scheduled game was the Sunday, December 5, 1981 State Final at Giants Stadium vs. Seton Hall Prep. The Pony Pirates prevailed 20-12.

Those games were *ALMOST* exclusively for Catholic school opponents, but SNYDER HS of Jersey City became the exception to the rule on Sunday, October 9, 1966. The Crusaders defeated the Tigers 40-19 at Bergen Catholic on that Sunday afternoon.

Other than Sundays and public-school Saturday games, Thanksgiving Thursdays were reserved for the Ironmen. That rivalry ran from 1958 through 1988 when the rivalry was all but dissolved and the schools were scheduled into separate divisions.

PLAYOFFS? PLAYOFFS!

This season, the Crusaders are in pursuit of their 20th State Championship. Since the inception of the playoff system in 1974, BC has made 45 appearances in the tournament and have reached the final 31 times. Of those title game appearances, Bergen has won 16 titles. Bergen has an overall record of 65-28 (.699) in tournament play.

SEMIFINAL SAGA

The Crusaders have played in 40 semifinal contests, winning 30 times, for a winning percentage of .750. You may notice that the number of thirty victories and 31 final appearances is off by one. That is because in 2003, the Crusaders and Ironmen of Don Bosco Prep were the only two teams to qualify for the NJSIAA Parochial "A" North Tournament. BC's first playoff game was a 1975 victory over Seton Hall Prep. The game was played at Fair Lawn High School, and it propelled the Crusaders into their first title game. Unfortunately, the Crusaders lost 7-7.

Yes, you read that correctly. In only its second year of tournament play, the NJSIAA's tiebreaker was the total number of yards a team could gain on four downs. DePaul's first possession saw them gain a number of

yards and then, due to an intercepted pass on BC's possession, the final decision was made.

BC has played St. Peter's Prep most often (9 times) in the semifinals. The Marauders hosted 6 of those games and hold a 5-4 advantage over BC. Don Bosco is next on the list with 6 semifinal matchups. Bergen is 4-2 over the Ironmen. Other opponents are St. Joseph Regional (3-1), Holy Cross (3-0), Immaculata (3-0), Notre Dame (3-0), Seton Hall Prep (2-1), Marist (2-0) and Holy Spirit and Queen of Peace, all 1-0.

2022 DONOVAN CATHOLIC GRIFFINS



The Griffins are coached by Dan Curcione. Coach Curcione has led the Griffins since 2017 and had an immediate positive impact on the program when he took over. From 0-10 the year prior to his commissioning, Curcione had the Griffins winning in year 1 and with a winning record in his second year.

In his seven seasons at the helm, the Griffins are 47-22, good for a .681 winning percentage. His 2019 (9-2) and 2020 (7-1) teams were the winningest in DC football this millennium and his overall record is finer than any DC coach of recent memory.

THE GRIFFINS ON OFFENSE



Behind the center, expect to see reliable senior, **Todd Lambertson (#10)** calling signals. More of a pocket passer and player who will beat you with his arm rather than his feet, he has completed over 56% of his passes for 957 yards and 10 touchdowns against only four interceptions. He has thrown for over 1500 yards and 14 touchdowns in his career. In last year's quarterfinal game against BC, Lambertson had a tough game, completing 11 of 19 passes for 92 yards, but throwing four interceptions to the Crusaders: two each to **Kaj Sanders #1** and **Naiim Parrish #5**.

Sophomore **Najee Calhoun (#4)** is the Griffins top rusher, nearly doubling his yards from last year with 1111. Calhoun leads the Griffins with 18 touchdowns on the season and is averaging 6.2 yards per carry. Receiver **Michael Thomas, III (#1)** is also dangerous in the running game, scampering for three touchdowns and 420 yards on 33 carries (12.7 ypc).

Junior **Michael Thomas, III (#1)** is once again Lambertson's favorite target. The junior has 33 receptions for 454 yards and three touchdowns. Keep your eye on sophomore **Emanuel Gerena (#18)**. The swift receiver has 6 catches for 89 yards and a TD. Near the goal line, the Donnies can go to soph **Jayden Nascimento (#9)**, 1 TD.

THE GRIFFINS ON DEFENSE

Isaac Correa (#11) leads the Donnies on defense with 68 tackles. He has 23 solo tackles including one for a loss, one interception and one fumble recovery. He is followed by **Joe Czerwinski (#33)** (64 tackles, 25 solo). Don't be surprised to hear **Roman Moyers (#8)** name called throughout the game. The senior has 55 tackles, 24 solos and an interception.

The Griffins have two formidable pass rushers, **Zaeir "Ducky" Day (#6)** (7 sacks, 6 TFLs) and senior **Hunter Johnson (#30)** (6 sacks, 5 TFLs).

THE GRIFFINS' SPECIAL TEAMS

Senior **Dante Priolo (#19)** handles the place-kicking responsibilities for the Griffins again this year. Building upon a strong junior campaign, he has hit on all 18 of his extra point attempts, which came in quite handy in the Griffins' 7-6 victory over St. Augustine Prep last week. He also has hit two of three field goals including a career long 51-yarder.

Beware of the fake when the Donnies' punt. Running back, **Najee Calhoun (#4)** is effective punting the ball (38.1 yards per punt), but in a game like this, everything is on the table. Calhoun is also their top kick returner.

GRIFFINS PLAYOFF HISTORY

The Griffins have made 17 playoff appearances and one appearance in the final. They have a record of 6-16, a .273 winning percentage.

NJSIAA PLAYOFFS: HOW WE GOT HERE



The **Crusaders** are the #1 seed in this year's Non-Public "A" Tournament. With only 13 qualifiers,

BC, second seeded Delbarton and third-seeded St. Joseph Regional earned byes into the quarterfinal round.

Bergen hammered Paul VI of Haddonfield last weekend 35-0 to advance to this semifinal game. The fourth-seeded **Griffins** defeated Paramus Catholic in dramatic fashion in the opening round. The Dons scored a 31-28 victory with a walk-off field goal to win it at the buzzer! From there, they hosted the Hermits from St. Augustine Prep. This was a rematch of the first week game in which the Griffins won 21-16. The playoff version of the game was a much tighter contest with Donovan Catholic making the critical interception to stop a last-ditch Hermit pass; final score 7-6.

On the other side of the bracket, **Delbarton** held off a ferocious 10th seeded Don Bosco Prep 14-9. The shocker of Saturday, however, was 11th seeded **Seton Hall Prep** knocking off St. Joseph Regional 35-28 in Montvale. That sets up a meeting between the Green Wave (9-1) and the Pirates (5-6) in Morristown.

If the Crusaders win today, they will host with winner of the Delbarton-SHP Game on Tuesday, November 28 at 8:00 PM at MetLife Stadium for the state championship.

CRUSADERS-GRIFFINS A SHORT HISTORY



The BC-DC rivalry spans two games. Bergen hosted the first quarterfinal round game (2021) that was stopped due to lightning storms and ultimately a lack of daylight. Ultimately, the game that started on November 13, 2021, ended on November 14, 2021, with the Crusaders advancing to the state semifinals with a 35-7 victory. Last season, the teams were able to decide an outcome, BC advancing 41-7 in the quarterfinals. This is the first time the two are meeting in the semifinal round of the state tournament.

The Crusaders will be playing for the sixth time (out of 7 total) at home on this date. It has been a very good day for the Crusaders, and they hope to keep the good times rolling with a victory today.

1967 - Larry Molloy took the opening kickoff back 77 yards to paydirt as the Crusaders rolled in a quagmire at 1040 Oradell Ave. John VonOhlen threw a 63-yard touchdown pass to John D'Amico and Bergen rolled to a 32-0 victory. The game would set up a league championship game on Thanksgiving with Don Bosco Prep.

1972 - In the first ever meeting between St. Peter's Prep and BC, Kevin Gray's first quarter TD led the way to Crusader victory. Brian McPartland recorded a couple of catches from Tim Cronin, who ran for a TD and also threw a TD pass to Pat Pirozzi. Joe Lally ran the ball hard for the Crusaders and BC got defensive help from Jim Skinner who intercepted a Marauder pass, helping to ensure the shutout.

1978 - Feaster, Feaster and more Feaster! John Feaster, father of current BC Head Lacrosse Coach and Assistant Varsity Football Coach, Frank Feaster, scored all 14 points to lead BC to a state playoff victory in the semi-finals against Queen of Peace. Two short TD runs and a two-point conversion reception from QB Ken Jagiello provided all the offense BC needed to advance to a state final match-up with nemesis Seton Hall Prep.

1989 - BC's first experience with quarterfinal-round football was a peculiar instance in 1989. During a time period when only four teams per section qualified for the state tournament. The only exception to that rule would be if an undefeated team had fewer power points than the teams who qualified ahead of them. Hence, Bergen hosted Queen of Peace on a very soggy, muddy, quagmire of a field. The difference in the game? Three made extra-points by the Crusaders. FB Jimmy Ruta carried for 204 yards and finished with 225 yards of total offense and a TD. Sophomore, Jimmy Taylor scored a

pair of TDs and current Wayne Valley Head Football Coach Roger Kotlarz '90 returned a fumble 77 yards for a TD to lead BC. And the kicker? John Daniello '91.

1995 - Homefield: Ramapo. Senior fullback Greg Boyajian carried six times for fifty yards and a TD and classmate, running back John Piela (father of BC's Matt Daly) ran for four TDs as the Crusaders eliminated Holy Cross of Delran in the Parochial 4 Semi-finals 55-21. The win provided BC the opportunity to avenge a 1994 State Championship loss to St. Peter's Prep. Bergen went onto its 4th crown in 5 seasons with a 19-7 victory over the Marauders at Giants Stadium.

2017 - Twenty-two years later, BC would play again on this date. This time, the Crusaders would defeat Delbarton enroute to their first and only state championship in the Nunzio Campanile era. Johnny Langan threw for 242 yards and four touchdowns and Aneas DiCosmo scored a pair of TDs to lead Bergen over the Green Wave 41-16.
