DECEMBER 7 - HACKENSACK, NJ - Alex Frassetto carried the puck to



his right and then behind the net. As he carried up the left wing, he saw a trailing Max Wright who was wide open in the slot. One perfect pass and one perfect shot later and the

Crusaders owned a 1-0 record with a dramatic 5-4 overtime victory over the Lions of Pope John XXIII of Sparta.

The assist topped off a strong day by Frassetto who finished with a goal and four assists. He helped the Crusaders take a 2-1 lead in the first intermission off a feed from Matt Maglio. Harrison Udis then propelled Bergen to a 3-1 advantage halfway through the second, but the Lions came back to tie it entering the third. Maglio recorded BC's fourth goal to give the home team the lead just 1:22 into the third, but the Crusaders were unable to hold off the Lions who tied it up with just 1:24 remaining in regulation.

Jacob Carver scored the Crusaders first goal of the 2023-24 campaign, assisted by Frassetto and Declan Quinn. The Crusaders received fine efforts in the goal by Erez Yacobi and Alessandro Capano. BC entered the game as the #8 ranked team in NJ and Pope John was ranked 16th.

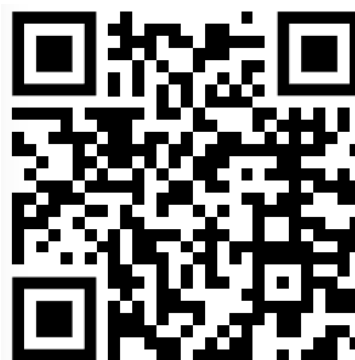


THOUGHTS ON MAKING THE MOST OF YOUR WINTER

BIRD OF THE YEAR!!!

RED-FLANKED BLUETAIL

DECEMBER 8 - MANCHESTER TWP., NJ - In perhaps the rarest sighting in the country this year, let alone New Jersey, residents of one small private community in Ocean Township were mobbed by hundreds of birders this past week in search of the state's first-ever recorded Red-flanked Bluetail. This bird is a Eurasian bird generally found in climates far colder than NJ.



This bird was fun to chase. The flock of birders were constantly moving, sometimes on the run as word spread of a recent sighting.



There was a very accommodating family, the Rikers, who seemed to enjoy the attention to their community this bird brought. We joined them in their backyard and Mrs. Rikers handed out home-baked Christmas cookies just before I took this photo of the bird.

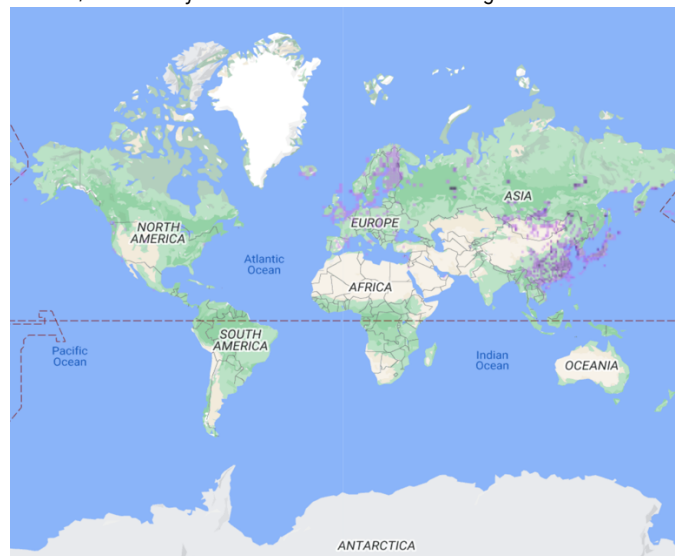

The violet shaded areas on the map are where this bird lives. As you can see, New Jersey is nowhere near its normal ranges.



So, what about this bird? It is an old-world flycatcher that lives in **taiga** and **montane** forests (**taiga** - cold subarctic forests, between the arctic tundra and the temperate forests to the south; **montane** - forests with coniferous and broadleaf trees).

The **Tarsiger cyanurus** (Latin name) can be hyperactive (this bird was moving low in search of insects and berries).

I had a great deal of fun chasing this bird after the 2-hour drive south. There were at least 6 birders from Bergen County that I met there and birders as far as New Milford, CT, Philadelphia and Long Island, though I'm sure there were more who came.

The red-flanked bluetail is not a rare bird insofar as it is not one of the endangered species. Whenever a bird like this appears, I am curious what others are around?
