## CRUSADERS - NJ TEAM OF YEAR PORTER - OFFENSIVE POTY SEVEN CRUSADER GRIDDER EARN ALL-STATE HONORS

### FIRST TEAM ALL STATE OFFENSE

**Quincy Porter** - junior wide receiver



Porter is considered New Jersey's most coveted recruit in the Class of 2025. Size and speed make the 6-4, 200-pounder a threat to score every time he touches the ball, and he had 53 receptions for 1,110 yards and 19 TDs. He had seven catches for 97 yards as the Crusaders (11-1) three-peated as Non-Public A titlist with a 24-14 win over

Delbarton. Porter has more than 20 major Division I scholarship offers.

**Marcus Linder** - senior lineman

Linder was the cornerstone of a balanced offense that averaged more than 330 yards per game and never scored fewer than 21 points. The 6-1, 255-pounder helped the Crusaders (11-1) pound their way to a third consecutive Non-Public A championship, as they pushed past Delbarton in the second half for a 24-14 victory. Linder is as hard-working off the field and is committed to Johns Hopkins.

### FIRST TEAM ALL STATE DEFENSE

**Elijah Kinsler** - senior lineman

Kinsler was the driving force for a defense that helped hold 10 of 12 opponents to 15 points or less. The 6-4, 255-pounder had 63 tackles, including eight for losses and 3.5 sacks, for the Crusaders (11-1). He had five tackles as the defense shut out Delbarton in the second half en-route to winning a third consecutive Non-Public A title with a 24-14 victory. He is committed to West Virginia.

**Kaj Sanders** - senior athlete

Sanders could be first-team All-State on either side of the ball, and that's the reason Rutgers is thrilled to have his commitment. The 6-2, 190-pounder is a fleet-footed defensive back who had 35 tackles and the ball was rarely thrown in his vicinity. He also showed his power while rushing

125 times for 1,053 yards and 17 TDs, and he ran for 110 yards and two scores in the Non-Public A title win over Delbarton.

## HOCKEY BLITZES HOLY GHOST

**DECEMBER 13 - HACKENSACK, NJ** - The Crusaders got things rolling early and often as Holy Ghost Prep visited the Ice House on Wednesday. Seniors Matt Maglio and Alex Frassetto rang the bell in the first five minutes to put the Crusaders up by a pair of goals. Maglio's goal was assisted by linemates, Jacob Carver and Harrison Udis. Frassetto was unassisted. Late in the period, Maglio found sophomore Will Schlechtweg pulled up in transition, blasting a wrist shot glove-side high to put Bergen up three after one period.



The Firebirds had a power play early in the second period, but the Crusader penalty killers scored a man-down goal three minutes into the period. Holy Ghost showed why they are coming off a state championship season, quickly answering with a power play goal to finish that penalty. Quinn Scribner, Alex Frassetto, Thomas Keough and Udis played solid defense in front of Erez Yacobi and killed off a second two-minute penalty by the Crusaders and the home team needed to change momentum.

After missing a scoring opportunity right in front of the net, BC overcommitted offensively, allowing for a Ghost skater to break away off a rebound. He translated his one-on-none into a goal and the lead was cut in half 4-2 halfway through the period.

BC was unable to take advantage of a power which ended around the 5-minute mark. Maglio had a wide-open look after receiving a pass from Declan Quinn, but the goalie made a phenomenal save, keeping Prep in the game.

The Crusaders got some nifty passing to register their fifth goal with just 33.9 seconds left in the middle period. Maglio centered the puck from the wing to Schlechtweg who slid the puck forward to Keough who converted the tic-tac-toe, giving BC a 5-2 advantage and momentum heading into the third period.

The Firebirds finally inched closer with a goal at the 6:10 mark, making the score 5-3. Yacobi made a dazzling stick save and was helped by Quin Scribner, playing crease defense and knocking a centering pass to the side.

The final ninety seconds saw a flurry of shots, but Yacobi was lights-out, turning away all six including a break away, a couple of point-blank wrist shots and two rebounds.

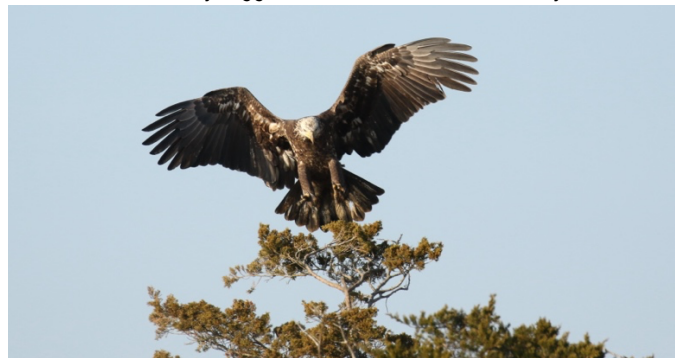
## BIRD OF THE WEEK

### BALD EAGLE

**NOVEMBER 26 - GREENWICH, CT AND DECEMBER 8 - GALLOWAY, NJ** - Br. Fagan entered Greenwich Point Park in November and we did not need to go far in order to spot a beautiful adult Bald Eagle sitting in a dead tree near the entrance to the first parking lot. To our amazement, many of the visitors to the park did not see the bird until we pointed it out, reminding me of one of the great truths in birding: the more you look, the more you see. This is an adult eagle, 6-years old or more.



The second bird I encountered as I travelled Edwin B. Forsythe NWR in Galloway, NJ. Notice the color of its bill and the colors of the feathers on its head and tail. They suggest that this is a two-and-a-half-year-old bird.
