

3 ALL-AMERICANS LEAD HISTORIC SWIM SEASON

season. With a 9-3 record, six top-eight state finishes, seven First Team All-County swimmers, and two NCIS All-American nominations, they finished strong.

Doyee Kim and Raymond Stelmark each set two different school records during the season. Kim broke the 200 IM, which BC Hall of Fame Coach, John Puzio thought was a "record that would never be broken." It was set originally by Andy O'Grady '87.

Kim also set the school record for the 100 Breast. Stelmark set marks in the 200 and 500 Free races. The 200 Free Relay record was refreshed by Eric Yoo, Ryan Choi, William Muller, and Dimitri Melnikov.

In the history of the program, the 2024 team became the sixth to win a sectional crown and advance to the State Final. In the end, the team took home league, county, and sectional titles.

Doyee Kim earned the All-American time in the 100 Breaststroke (54.91 from finals at the state MOCs) and the consideration time in the 200 IM (1:51.07 from the state final), Dimitri has the consideration times in the 100 Breast (55.87 from the state final) and 200 IM (1:51.48 from the prelims of the state MOCs) and Raymond has the consideration time in the 500 Freestyle (4:30.89 from finals at the state MOCs).



GRAPPLERS CONTINUE TO DOMINATE DISTRICTS

MARCH 19 - ORADELL, NJ - BY, YOUSSEF OUDA '24 AND SEAN WRENN '24 - This wrestling season the Crusaders won their 35th district

title and 34th in a row. In dual competition, BC went 7-7 and reached the Parochial "A" North Section Semi-finals.



Fleven wrestlers won individual district titles including sophomores Nathan Braun, Chad Sadaka and Mason Marck; juniors Logan Cantone, Genti Idrizi and Benji Shue; seniors, Chris Nucifora, Noah Kochman, Jayden Iznaga, Ryan Ford and Leo Varga. Sophomore Daniel Washburn placed second in the district, earning a spot in

the regionals. The Team dominated the event, scoring 298 points, 99 points ahead of second-place Caldwell (199) and 200 points ahead of third place third-place North Bergen (98).

Nine grapplers qualified for the state tournament in Atlantic City as five won Region titles: Nathan Braun, Chris Nucifora, Noah Kochman, Jayden Iznaga and Ryan Ford. Four Crusaders finished second including Genti Idrizi, Leo Varga, Mason Marck and Benji Shue. Five wrestlers placed in states as well.

Senior Ryan Ford hit 100 wins this season as well while also finishing 4th in the state. Senior Jayden Iznaga also had himself a great year with taking 5th in states.
